From the Pastor

Splendid India Tour 5

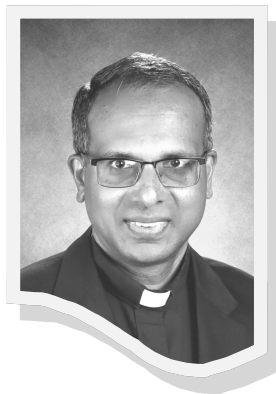
The final day of our tour began with a visit to the school I attended. The students were just going into the school, and they were delighted to see all of us. They were so full of life and joy.

The seating in the classrooms has not changed much, except that now they have a whiteboard and a video projector. I looked for my name that I had written on one of the desks, but I couldn't find it.

There are about 760 students enrolled in Classes 5 to 10, and they have only about 12 computers for all the students—yet they are happy.

After we visited a few classrooms, we spent a few minutes with the students and teachers taking pictures. Then we made our way to the church to attend the wedding of my cousin.

It was a lovely Wedding Mass celebrated in the Syro-Malabar Rite—one of the two Eastern Rites celebrated in Kerala, India. Though the Roman rite is the largest in the Catholic Church, there are another 21 rites that make up the Catholic Church in India, which is the home of three rites: the Syro-malabar rite, Syro-malankara rite, and the Roman rite. I was baptized and ordained in the Syro-malabar rite. All the rites in the Catholic Church believe and profess the same faith. The difference is in the way liturgy is celebrated. The liturgical vestments are different, and they have a lot more singing and prayers in the Syro-malabar rite.



After the wedding Mass, we accompanied the newlyweds to the reception hall for the traditional ceremony which follows ancient Jewish customs of blessing the newlyweds by the parents, receiving them into the new family, giving milk and fruits to the couple, cutting the cake, and officially inviting all the guests to the banquet by the uncles of the bride and groom. After the ceremony, we walked over to my cousin Fr. Joseph's house for the reception with food and drinks.



After spending a relaxing time and doing a little shopping in my hometown, we returned to the hotel where we gathered at 6 p.m. to share our thoughts, surprises, and the many experiences of our trip. We then had dinner, checked out of the hotel, and left for the Kochi Airport at 10 p.m., carrying with us the numerous memories of a once-in-a-lifetime trip.



There will be a Power Point Presentation on our Splendid India Tour on **Sunday, April 14th—after the 10 am. Mass**—in the Community Center. Please join us to see and hear more. Most of those who were on the tour plan to be there in their India “dress” to explain and answer your questions. There will be refreshments and a display of the things we brought back from India. Hope to see you there!

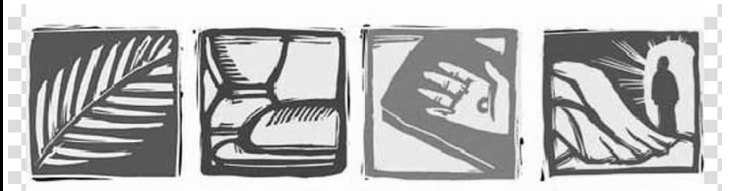

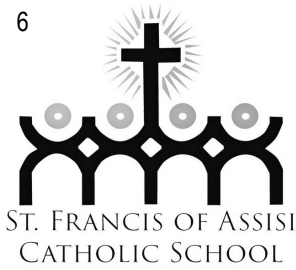
