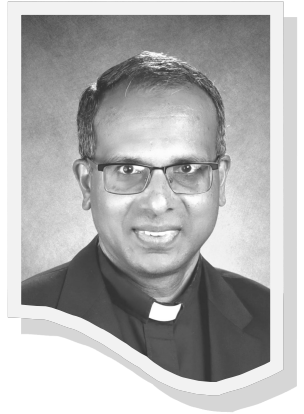

The National Eucharistic Pilgrimage

The National Eucharistic Pilgrimage is not one event or a road trip—it is an exciting opportunity for American Catholics everywhere to physically embody our nation’s journey of Eucharistic Revival. Whether you are on the shores of Hawaii or in the mountains of Alaska, needing to stay close to home or deployed overseas, you are invited to be a part of this journey.

A pilgrimage is “the simultaneous movement of the feet and the soul”—a journey made both externally and internally. The pilgrims travel to a location of spiritual significance, stepping outside of themselves in order to encounter God in places where He has revealed Himself. This action mirrors the interior journey of the pilgrim, who uses this experience to draw closer to Our Lord and seek Him more intentionally.

The value of a pilgrimage is not in the distance traveled but in the disposition of our own hearts and the zeal with which we seek God. Many saints have had life-changing experiences while on a pilgrimage, and the practice has been a part of Christianity from the beginning.

Jesus doesn’t want us to walk alone. At the Incarnation, Christ entered directly into our human experience, allowing Him to accompany us through life in a more intimate way.

But physically walking with Jesus is not a privilege restricted to Christians from the first century! When Jesus gave us the gift of the Eucharist, He gave us a new way to walk alongside Him.

Catholicism now has a vibrant history of Eucharistic processions! In this tradition, the Eucharist is carried through the streets, accompanied by the faithful. We walk publicly with Our Lord so that others may encounter Him personally, just as they did 2,000 years ago.

The National Eucharistic Pilgrimage is a truly unique initiative. This is something NEW—a beautiful fusion of the journey TO Jesus and the journey WITH Jesus. What’s more, it is an adventure that all Catholics can do together—either by interior disposition—or physical accompaniment. We accompany Jesus in the Eucharist from the north, south, east, and west edges of our country, stopping at many holy sites and churches along the way.

This journey with Christ on His way will culminate at the 10th National Eucharistic Congress, where He comes to encounter His people anew.

The four pilgrimage routes—the *Marian Route*, the *Seton Route*, the *Juan Diego Route*, and the *Serra Route*—are part of our Eucharistic Caravan. The Junipero Serra Route will be the longest and most challenging branch of the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage—covering over 2,200 miles! We are very specially blessed as this route of the Eucharistic Pilgrimage will pass through our Diocese. This route will enter our Diocese of Baker from the Diocese of Reno at McDermitt, OR/NV on **Sunday, May 26th**. It will stop in Burns, Juntura, Vale, and depart the Diocese from Blessed Sacrament Church, in Ontario, on **Memorial Day, May 27th**, in a Solemn Eucharistic Procession to Corpus Christi, Fruitland, ID, in the Diocese of Boise.

We have chartered a bus here at St. Francis to take those interested in taking part in this portion of the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage. The bus will leave St. Francis at **5:45 a.m. on Monday, May 27th**, to join the procession from Burns to Ontario and return at about **11 p.m.** Please see our Parish Website, Parish Bulletin, or call the Parish Office for details and to register.

This is a unique opportunity, and you do not want to miss it! Seats are limited. Register right away! There are several buses expected from the Dioceses of Seattle, Spokane, Yakima, and Portland.

A decree issued by the Apostolic Penitentiary and approved by **Pope Francis** indicates that the ***plenary indulgence*** will be granted to the Christian faithful who participate in the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage at any point between **May 17th and July 16th**. It will also be granted to the elderly, infirm, and all those who cannot leave their homes for a serious reason and who participate in spirit with the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage, uniting their prayers, pains, or inconveniences with Christ and the pilgrimage. This indulgence is granted under the usual conditions of sacramental Confession, Eucharistic Communion, and prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father.

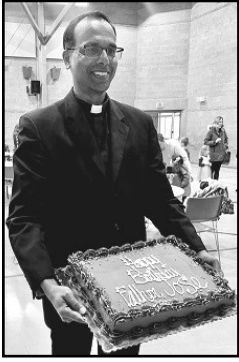

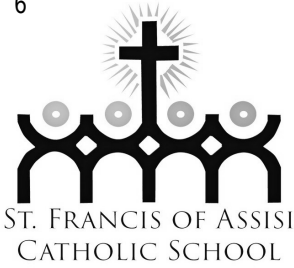


