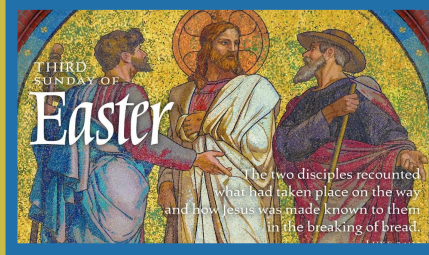

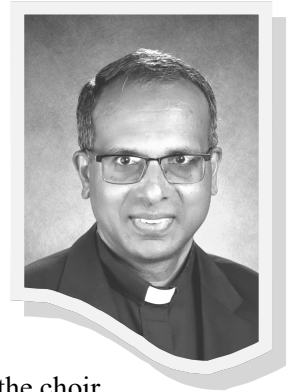

Historic Church Renovation and Restoration Update

It has been about three months since I wrote about the progress of the renovation and restoration of our Historic Church. We had an open house on March 22nd, and several of you came by to see the progress we have made and talked to those doing the amazing work. There was so much excitement to see what we have achieved already. The Daprato Rigali Studios have completed its portion of the work:

- ▶ The sanctuary is now finished with a new floor, a new altar, a new ambo and a new baptismal font.
- ▶ The back wall of the sanctuary has been cleaned, patched, painted and divided into three sections to give it dimension and depth. The sections were stencil-painted with a Tau Cross and two crossed arms: the right hand of Christ nailed to the Cross and the left hand of St. Francis with the stigmata.
- ▶ The reredos has been cleaned and gold-leafed, and it now looks stunning with the tiled flooring. All of the statues have been refinished and reinstalled. They look amazingly beautiful!
- ▶ The Sacred Heart statue of Jesus is now right at the center, and it catches your eye as soon as you enter the Church.
- ▶ Columns have been installed on both sides of the sanctuary wall, and shrines have been built for both Mary and Joseph. The altar, ambo and baptismal font now match everything in the sanctuary.
- ▶ The presider's, deacon's, and acolyte's chairs have arrived, and the Communion rail is back to give its original look. Also, the broken tabernacle has been repaired, refinished and reinstalled. It is absolutely beautiful.
- ▶ All the stained-glass windows have been reinstalled. Each of them was shipped to Rigali Studios, taken out piece by piece and re-leaded so that they can last another century. The outer protective flexi glass has been replaced with real glass making it possible to see the windows.
- ▶ Most exterior work has been completed except for the repair on the roofing above the entry door.
- ▶ The bricks have been cleaned and sealed and some of them replaced, and cracked window frames have been repaired or refinished and painted.
- ▶ The bell towers have been cleaned of a century's accumulation of bird droppings.

- ▶ The railing has been installed in the choir loft to meet the code
- ▶ The sanctuary has been made handicap accessible.
- ▶ The sound system and security camera installations are in progress, but there is still more lighting that needs to be installed.
- ▶ New cabinets have been installed in the sacristy, and the new flooring is in progress.
- ▶ New stained-glass windows have been installed in the sacristy, replacing the colored glass windows.
- ▶ The basement prep which has been a major project is in progress—the HVAC is scheduled to arrive in mid-April.

The final date for the completion of Phase I of the renovation is May 31st. I hope to have the blessing and rededication in June.

The second phase of the project would consist of refinishing the pews, flooring, lighting, walls, ceiling, Stations of the Cross, and the confessionals in the nave, as well as refinishing the entry way. This phase will cost about \$1.3 million. We are now doing a survey to get your feedback. Please take a paper survey or an online survey to give your feedback. Your input will determine the direction we take.

The City of Bend has chosen our project for their annual Historic Preservation Month presentation which is in May. There will be several people associated with the Historic Building Preservation from all over Oregon who will be visiting the Historic Church next month. All are welcome to the Open House today from 2 to 5 p.m.

The beauty and solidity of the Historic Church shows the beauty and solidity of our Catholic Faith. The community is so lucky to have something like this here in Bend. We want to make sure that the Church is here for generations to come, bringing people faith and hope.

The presence of the Church is a constant reminder to all of the presence of God. The previous generation built the Church, and now it is our turn to make sure that it is here for the next generation.

Thanks to all who have supported this renovation effort and who continue to do so.

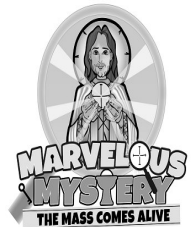

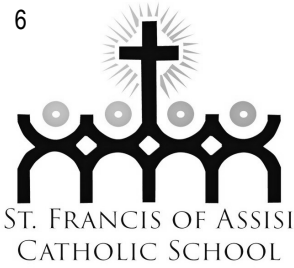
