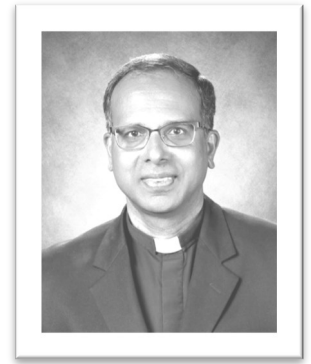

D From the Pastor

The Holy Week



The Holy Week begins on April 13th with the observance of Palm Sunday. The Holy Week is ordered in the commemoration of Christ's Passion, beginning with his Messianic entrance into Jerusalem. The days of Holy Week, from Monday to Thursday inclusive, have precedence over all other celebrations.

It is recommended, except in danger of death, that baptisms or confirmations are not to be celebrated on these days because they have their natural place in the Easter Vigil. The Passion of the Lord dominates the entire Holy Week. It is a customary practice to drape the crucifix and statues wherever it is possible to do so.

Palm Sunday

On Palm Sunday the church recalls the entrance of Christ the Lord into Jerusalem to accomplish His Paschal Mystery. Accordingly, the memorial of this entrance of the Lord takes place at all Masses, by means of procession or the solemn entrance before the principal Mass, or the simple entrance before other Masses.

The solemn entrance may be repeated before other Masses that are usually celebrated with a large gathering of people.

We will be beginning the Masses in the narthex of the Church on Palm Sunday. You are welcome to grab a palm as you come out to the narthex and hold them in your hands for the blessing.

After the blessing, when directed please follow the cross all the way to the steps of the sanctuary in procession and then to go to the pew where you plan to sit.

The Rite of Blessing of the Palms and the procession will take the place of the Introductory Rite of the Mass, and when the priest gets up to the altar, he says the Collect of the Mass, and then continues the Mass in the usual way.

The Gospel of the Passion of the Lord is read without a gospel procession and greeting and signing of the book. It is read with a Narrator, the Voice, the Priest, and the Congregation, each reading their portion. Please follow along in *Breaking Bread*, and read the part of the Crowd (C). At the end of the reading, the book is not kissed, but "The gospel of the Lord" is said with its response, "Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ."

Chrism Mass

The only Masses permitted on Holy Thursday are the Chrism Mass and the evening Mass of the Lord's Supper. Due to obvious reasons, the Chrism Mass in our diocese is always celebrated in the Cathedral Church in Baker City on the Thursday before Holy Thursday, which is April 10th this year at 11 a.m. Fr. Roga and I will be away to participate in it. There will be no Masses here on Wednesday and Thursday, April 9th and 10th.

If anyone wishes to participate in the Chrism Mass, you are welcome to make the trip. If you have not been to our beautiful Cathedral Church in Baker City, I highly recommend making the trip. This will also be a Pilgrimage in this Jubilee Year. The Mass of Chrism is properly celebrated by the Bishop with his clergy. It is a sign of unity and communion of the priests with their Bishop.

The blessing of the Oils—the Oil of Catechumens, the Oil of Chrism, and the Oil of the Sick—takes place at this Mass. The newly blessed Oils are then brought to the individual parishes and presented to the people at the Mass of the Lord's Supper and used throughout the year to anoint the sick and in baptisms and confirmations. The old oils are either burned or poured into the lamp that burns before the reserved Blessed Sacrament.
