From the Pastor



The Parables and Their Difficulty Without the Guidance of the Magisterium of the Catholic Church

The parables told by Jesus are short symbolic stories that express profound spiritual truths. At first glance, they may seem simple, but they have such complex meanings that they can be difficult to understand without good guidance. Some difficulties that may arise are:

a) Symbolic ambiguity: This means that the parables operate with metaphors and analogies that can have multiple interpretations. Without doctrinal authority, there is a risk of falling into erroneous or contradictory interpretations (cf. CCC137).

b) They have an historical and cultural context: Many parables are steeped in first-century customs. The Magisterium enriches knowledge of this historical context when applying the message in a contemporary way (cf. PRESENTATION BY CARDINAL JOSEPH RATZINGER ON THE OCCASION OF THE 100TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE PONTIFICAL BIBLICAL COMMISSION).

c) Some have an open ending: Some parables do not clarify their meaning. Often, Jesus only revealed the meaning of the parables to His disciples, and the emphasis on explaining them univocally opens the door to confusion if they are read independently of the context (cf. *Dei Verbum* #3).

With these points in mind, I can say that there is a risk of subjectivism. Without an official interpretation, each person would be encouraged to adapt the message to their own imagination, thus distorting the Gospel.

Thank God, we have the Magisterium of the Church, which helps us achieve a sound interpretation. As the Church's teaching authority, it helps explain the parables; it is a faithful and consistent interpretation of the parables that evokes Tradition, Scripture, and the guidance of the Holy Spirit, thus preventing doctrinal division.

Let us remember that in our personal prayer, God speaks to us, but what He tells us never goes against His own teachings. Perhaps in our meditation on Sacred Scripture, and particularly on the parables, we may misunderstand something.

That is why I always invite you to consult and be guided by the documents of the Catholic Church, whether encyclicals, apostolic constitutions, apostolic exhortations, apostolic letters, *motu proprio*, papal bulls, and apostolic briefs—in addition to the Catechism of the Catholic Church.

With this guide, we ensure that we preserve pastoral doctrine, avoid theological error, and delve deeper into Christ's saving message.

Help St. Clare's Helpers Celebrate!

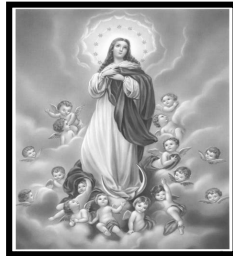

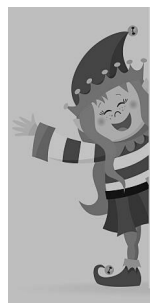
