# **D** From the Pastor



## Speaking About Evil . . .

**R**egarding In the passage of Luke 13:22–30, we are told how Jesus, while on His way to Jerusalem, teaches about the “narrow door,” and warns that many will try to enter, but they will not be able to.

In His message, He mentions people who will be left out of the banquet of the Kingdom because they “did evil.”

For the Catholic Church, in the context of this passage, doing evil is not limited only to grave and obvious acts of injustice such as theft, violence, or adultery, but also includes:

**a. Living in opposition to God’s will**  
Doing evil is acting against love for God and neighbor, which is the core of divine law (cf. Mt 22:37-40). It is not enough to “know” or “have heard” Jesus; we must obey His Word and live it (cf. Lk 6:46). In this passage, Jesus reproaches those who heard His teaching but did not put it into practice.

**b. Lack of conversion**  
In moral terms, the Church defines sin as “an offense against reason, truth, and right conscience; it is a failure in genuine love” (Catechism 1849). In Luke 13, doing evil can refer both to sins of commission (wrong actions) and sins of

omission (failing to do good when one could do so, cf. Jas 4:17).

### **c. False confidence in external closeness to Jesus**

Those left outside say: “We ate and drank in your company,” meaning they had an external contact with Him but not a transforming relationship. According to Catholic teaching, external membership in the Church or participation in rites is not enough; authentic conversion of the heart and works consistent with faith are necessary.

### **d. Final consequence**

In the passage, doing evil leads to being excluded from the Kingdom. The Church interprets this as a warning: the final judgment will not be based on religious appearances, but on the truth of a life lived in love and justice.

### **CONCLUSION:**

Rather than focusing on the evil in others, we are called to open our eyes to the good that God pours into our lives. Only by receiving and embracing His grace can we offer that good to others and walk through the narrow door that leads to the Kingdom.
