

# From the Pastor



## Divine Renovation Conference: Evangelization by Invitation

**A Church exists to evangelize—it is a priority of the Church.**

Evangelization is not a new term. *Evangelii Nuntiandi* (“Evangelization in the Modern World”) is the apostolic exhortation issued by Pope Pius VI in 1975. It says, “It is the duty incumbent on her (the Church) by the command of the Lord Jesus, so that people can believe and be saved.” This message is indeed necessary. It is unique. It cannot be replaced.

“She exists in order to evangelize,” said Pope St. John Paul II, speaking of the importance of evangelization in his encyclical, *Redemptoris Missio* (“Mission of the Redeemer”), published in 1990. He speaks of the vocation of the Church to evangelize: “The Church, in fact, cannot withdraw from her permanent mission of bringing the Gospel to the multitudes—the millions and millions of men and women—who as yet do not know Christ the Redeemer of humanity. In a specific way this is the missionary work which Jesus entrusted and still entrusts each day to His Church.”

In the apostolic exhortation *Evangelii Gaudium* (“The Joy of the Gospel”), Pope Francis calls the Church to a new chapter of evangelization: “As those who have encountered Jesus, we are called to share the joy of the Gospel. Each Christian and every community must discern the path that the Lord points out, but all of us are asked to obey His call to go forth from our own comfort zone in order to reach all the ‘peripheries’ in need of the light of the Gospel.”

Evangelization is **not a program or a course**. *It is bringing the Gospel of Jesus, the good news, to the people so that they can make a choice to follow Him and become His disciples. Disciples* are those who have had an encounter with Christ, experienced a transformation in their lives, and they have surrendered to His will and have chosen to follow Him. We have to make disciples before we can form them and send them out. As a Church, this is our business—to make disciples. **We want to make disciples—not just members.**

**Invitation** is the **first step** to making disciples. Studies show that you have to invite someone at least five times before he/she says “Yes.” Unfortunately, most of our churches do not have **culture** invitation. Inviting others to Church or sharing our faith experience is not something that falls into the **comfort zone** for many Catholics. The worst thing that can happen is that

someone **turns down** your invitation. That is OK. We can take “No” for an answer. But persist! Be intentional in invitation. Share your faith stories. *Faith is “caught” and not “taught.”* Celebrate faith experiences and the transformation/conversion stories. Let people know that this is why we exist.

Invitation is only the first step. The **second step** is to create a **culture of hospitality**. Without it, invitation will not bear fruit. Creating an atmosphere of hospitality takes intentionality. Hospitality communicates to others that they matter, and they are important. Then they will begin to think that there is a God in heaven who cares. It is creating a sense of “welcome” that leads to a sense of “belongingness.” At the conference in Dallas, TX, that I attended recently, there were people greeting us and welcoming us from the parking lot. There was a great sense of hospitality and welcome—and we could feel it!

Hospitality connects the message of God’s love with everyday living. It opens us up to God’s message, and that Jesus wants to have a relationship with everyone. People will not be theologically aware until they are sociologically comfortable. As long as they are guarded or uncomfortable, they are not going to be open to the truth of whom Jesus is. Hospitality creates a conducive atmosphere to hear God’s message. Radical hospitality creates a sense of belonging. It is like preparing the soil to plant seeds. It is the first step. The next two steps are to **believe and behave**. It is to belong, to believe and to behave. This is Jesus’ model. Once someone feels a sense of belonging, he/she will be interested in what we believe. Once they believe, they will behave according to their belief.


