From the Pastor



St. Bernard of Clairvaux (1090–1153), the great Cistercian abbot and Doctor of the Church, wrote extensively on humility and pride, especially in his treatise “On the Steps of Humility and Pride” (*De gradibus humilitatis et superbiae.*)

The Two Ladders: Pride vs. Humility

Degrees of Pride (Descent away from God)

1. Curiosity—a restless, prying mind
2. Levity of mind—frivolity, lack of seriousness
3. Foolish mirth—mocking laughter, lack of reverence
4. Boasting—speaking proudly of one’s deeds
5. Singularity—seeking to stand out or be different for vanity
6. Arrogance—claiming superiority over others
7. Presumption—assuming honors, claiming rights not given
8. Defensiveness—rejecting correction, making excuses
9. Hypocritical confession—false humility in admitting faults
10. Rebellion—refusal of obedience, resistance to authority
11. Freedom to sin—shamelessness, sinning openly
12. Habitual sinning—enslavement to sin, blindness of soul

Degrees of Humility (Ascent toward God)

1. Fear of God—reverence and awe before Him
2. Restraint of the will—submission to God’s law, not self-will
3. Obedience – ready submission to lawful authority
4. Patience – enduring trials without complaint
5. Confession of faults—open acknowledgment of sins
6. Contentment with the lowest satisfaction with humble tasks and places
7. Self-consideration – seeing oneself as least and unworthy
8. Avoidance of singularity—conforming humbly to community life
9. Restraint of speech—speaking only with modesty and purpose
10. Grave demeanor—modest, recollected bearing
11. Gentle speech—meek, humble, peaceful words
12. Constant humility of heart—abiding disposition of lowliness before God

St. Bernard shows that both ladders are **progressive**: Pride begins with small vanities and ends in hardened sin. Humility begins with holy fear and ends in the soul’s union with God.

Many monastic writers after him used this “double ladder” as a spiritual diagnostic tool, so let us use this *double ladder* to diagnose our spiritual life.

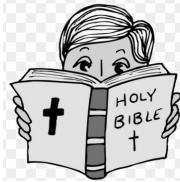
