From the Pastor



As Catholics, we often do not read the beautiful teachings of the Fathers of the Church, which they mediated and thought about Jesus' teachings. Here I want to present some about the "Parable of the Rich Fool" (cf. Luke 12:13-21). The Church Fathers interpreted this passage as a powerful warning against greed, materialism, and spiritual negligence.

Luke 12:13–21 (Summary)

A man asks Jesus to intervene in a family inheritance dispute. Jesus refuses and tells a parable: A rich man has a great harvest and plans to store it all, saying to himself, "You have many goods laid up for many years; eat, drink, and be merry." But God calls him a fool, saying that very night his soul will be demanded of him. Jesus concludes: "So is he who lays up treasure for himself and is not rich toward God."

Teachings of the Church Fathers

1. St. Augustine of Hippo (354–430)

St. Augustine frequently taught that greed is a form of idolatry. In this parable, the rich man is condemned not for his wealth, but for his selfishness and presumption. He says the man spoke only to himself, showing he had no relationship with others—or with God. His "soul" is focused on material comfort, not eternal life.

"The rich man planned to fill his soul with feasting, not with wisdom. His soul was full, but not rich toward God."

—*Sermon 36, on the Gospel of Luke*

2. St. Basil the Great (c. 330–379)

St. Basil criticizes hoarding and teaches that excess wealth is theft from the poor. He sees the barns as symbols of greed and says that rather than building larger storage, the rich man should have shared with the needy.

"The things you store belong to the poor. You are keeping what belongs to others."

—*Homily on Luke 12*

3. St. John Chrysostom (c. 347–407)

St John Chrysostom emphasizes that the rich man is concerned only with his own pleasure, and not with God's will or others' needs.

He highlights the foolishness of earthly security, which can vanish instantly.

"His soul is required, and his barns are useless. See how all his plans perished with his breath."

—*Homilies on the Gospel of Luke*

4. Origen of Alexandria (c. 185–254)

Origen gives an allegorical interpretation: the "barns" represent the heart, which the man fills with earthly concerns instead of the Word of God.

He sees the soul as starved of true nourishment, focused instead on vanity.

"He had no treasure in heaven, only on earth, and so when his soul was required, he was found empty."

5. Ambrose of Milan (c. 340–397)

St. Ambrose teaches that true wealth is spiritual, and being "rich toward God" means doing works of mercy and living in faith.

He connects the parable to Christian stewardship, reminding believers that all possessions are entrusted to them by God.

We can conclude that: Greed distorts the soul, turning it inward and away from love. Material security is an illusion; death can come at any time.

Then we can use: Generosity toward the poor is how one becomes "rich toward God." Wisdom is inviting us to live with eternity in mind, using our wealth to the benefit of the Kingdom of God.

Lord, free our hearts from greed and fear. Teach us to store treasures in heaven by loving You and serving our neighbor. May we never be fools in Your sight, but faithful stewards of all You entrust to us. Amen.
