

From the Pastor

Come! Celebrate! Connect! Part 1

COVID is still with us, and maybe it will be with us forever. This should not prevent us from living our faith. There are now vaccines and effective treatments for this disease. What more can we expect? There are several parishioners (about 30%) who have not returned to church. If you can be in a store, a restaurant, a party, or on a flight where you are shoulder to shoulder, then there is no reason not to be in church. In the church, you do not have to sit shoulder to shoulder. Our 27th St. Church holds 800 people, but it has not been more than 60% full since the pandemic. While we appreciate your presence online, we would really love your physical presence with us if you're not sick or limited by some serious underlying conditions. It is within a community of believers that we worship and grow.

As COVID restrictions are rolled back, and we move fully into our parish life and activities, I would like to invite you to a special celebration: **Come! Celebrate! Connect! on August 13th and 14th after all the Masses.** It is an invitation to **Come!** to see what St. Francis has to offer you to learn, grow and serve. It is an invitation to **Celebrate!** the Holy Eucharist with us, who we are as Catholics, and to give thanks to God. It is an invitation to **Connect!** with fellow parishioners and with the life and activities of the parish. It is an invitation to be the good stewards God has called you to be.

I know that we have a number of new families who have joined our parish during the past year. It is an invitation to get to know the members of our church family. We will have food and refreshments after all the Masses at the 27th St. Church. **Come! Celebrate! Connect!** will provide the opportunity to get involved in the life and activities of the parish. All the ministries in the parish will be in display under the titles learn, grow, and serve.

Jesus has called each of us to follow Him, and we have responded to that call by our baptism. In our fast paced, consumer-oriented society, it is often difficult to live our baptismal call. But there is a solution. In the Bible, God asks us to live as good stewards. **Stewardship is a way of life that brings God into the center of our daily living.** It is a way of living each day in gratitude for all the blessings that God has given to us. It is becoming His intentional disci-

ples. **The goal of our life is holiness, and stewardship is the practical way to get there.**

In 1992, the U.S. Catholic Bishops released a pastoral letter on stewardship entitled: *Stewardship: A Disciple's Response*. I would encourage everyone to read this to get to know more about stewardship.

My space is limited here to give a detailed explanation of what stewardship is. However, the pastoral letter gives a wonderful and detailed explanation of stewardship. It can be found on the USCCB website: <http://www.usccb.org/stewardship/disciplesresponse.pdf>.

The bishops' letter on stewardship did not deal with money because they realized that money was not the problem. Money was only a symptom of something else. The Catholic Church in this country had a very humble beginning. Today, the U.S. Catholics have a network of churches, schools, and charitable institutions. They are the result of the stewardship of our Catholic ancestors. Will our ancestors be happy with the way we live and spend our time, talents, and resources?

It is when we put these at the service of the Kingdom of God that we fulfill our Mission. The Church needs your helping hands. We have several paid positions open as well, both at the parish and school, by which you can help carry out our Mission.

*For as in one body we have many members,
and not all the members have the same function,
so we, who are many,
are one body in Christ,
and individually
we are members one of another.*

*We have gifts that differ
according to the grace given to us:
prophecy, in proportion to faith;
ministry, in ministering;
the teacher, in teaching;
the exhorter, in exhortation;
the giver, in generosity;
the leader, in diligence;
the compassionate, in cheerfulness.
