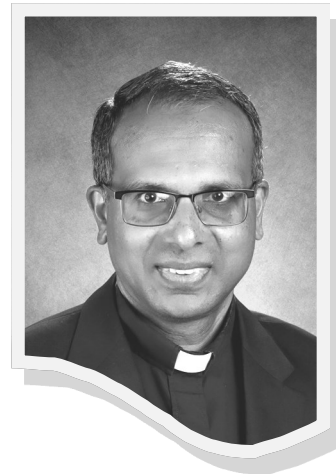

Religious Retirement

Pope Francis often highlights the role older adults play in conveying faith from one generation to the next. Recently, he noted that “there is no retirement age from the work of proclaiming the Gospel.”

As this is the Annual Religious Retirement Collection weekend, we are all reminded that senior religious never retire from their vows. Instead, the prayer and ministry of older priests and religious are an ongoing witness to the Gospel.

Our Diocesan priests have served the Church, and they have done so for relatively little material reward. These dedicated priests deserve a just retirement for their committed years of service to the diocese. While we understand the importance of supporting the national collection, we too must take care of our own priests who have served so faithfully in the Diocese of Baker. Over the past 35 years, the Diocese of Baker has sent \$1,549,926 to the national office for this collection. In 2022, we received \$108,686 for the Religious Retirement Collection and 10 percent of the net collection was sent to the national office. The remainder stayed in our diocese.

The priests of the Diocese of Baker have their own Health and Retirement Association. When a priest from this diocese retires, he receives payments of \$1,800 per month from the Association. Our priests also receive Medicare Supplement Insurance.

Additionally, the Health and Retirement Association makes payments to the Dioceses of our foreign-born priests based on a “years-of-service schedule” after they have served in our Diocese.

The Health and Retirement Association currently has about \$2,025,000 in assets, most of which is invested in the Legacy of Faith Catholic Community Foundation of Oregon for the priests of the Diocese of Baker. As most of you already know, the Diocesan pension plan is significantly underfunded.

Because of our large, unfunded pension liability, the Diocese of Baker will again allocate the majority of this collection to the Priest’s Retirement Program. We will continue to support the religious sisters and brothers who have served in our Diocese by remitting a portion of this collection to the national office. This collection and our own Bishop’s Annual Appeal are two of the major funding sources.

The Annual Collection for the Retirement Fund is conducted in our diocese this weekend, **December 9th and 10th**, to correspond with all the other dioceses across the nation as we have typically done in years past. Let us continue to support this important and necessary collection. The envelopes are in the narthex and in the pews.

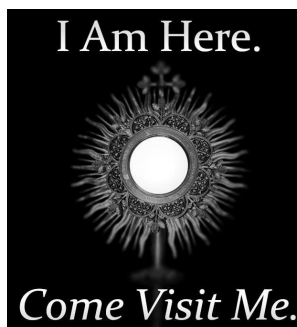

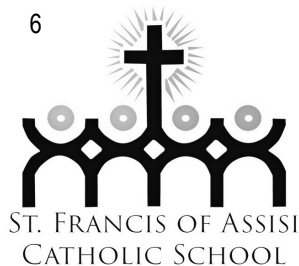

Did you know . . . ?

Saint Francis School has space in most of our classrooms. We have expanded our staffing in Pre-K, Kindergarten, 1st Grade, and Middle School so we have more room for motivated scholars.

Our STREAM curriculum encourages integration of the Arts into the technical studies of STEM. This allows us to offer an emotionally healthy, well-rounded academic experience.

Pre-K meet in the library and with the PE specialist each week. Our Kindergarten through 5th Graders have 15 classes with 6 specialists. Middle Schoolers have a daily elective period plus Religion and Spanish.

The Sisters, Daughters of Mary Help of Christians, provide Religion classes three days a week that are considered academic core classes, and we attend Mass as a school community every Wednesday.

Cognia is our accreditation partner. Accreditation helps us focus on continuous improvement. In this cycle we are focusing on career and technical courses.

We are looking at some new financial aid sources to partner with our existing scholarship fund to make a Catholic education more accessible.
