



## From the Pastor



### The Good News of Great Joy

**I** was in the Holy Land only a year ago, together with 28 others, on a pilgrimage, but it feels like a long time ago for obvious reasons. We have been through a long, unusual year. However, we still have a lot to be grateful for despite the COVID situation. We have learned to better appreciate the simple things of daily life, and how important the Eucharist and the other sacraments are to us, as well as the fellowship we all came to enjoy. I am very encouraged by the number of people from near and far who tune into our live-streamed Masses each week. I look forward to when we ALL can be together again. St. Paul reminds us, “Rejoice always, pray continually, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God’s will for you in Christ Jesus” (1Thes 5:18).

In our St. Francis of Assisi Parish in Bend, we began to live-stream the liturgy a week before the pandemic shutdown. All weekday and weekend Masses were live-streamed, including the Divine Mercy Chaplet and the Rosary. The Holy Week Services were particularly hard to celebrate without you—the Church family. Our parish staff and volunteers called all of our parishioners whose information we have to check on their welfare. The Historic Church was open for personal prayer, and we made available scapulars, medallions, holy water, blessed salt, and face masks for physical and spiritual support. As soon as we were allowed, we re-opened the church for in-person celebrations with restricted numbers. From that point until now, there have been many changes and adjustments, depending upon the number of Corona virus cases in the State and in Deschutes County.

We continue to live-stream our Masses for those who cannot join us in person. At St. Francis Parish and School, we have taken all possible steps to keep everyone safe during our time together. The students at St. Francis School are blessed to have in-person learning. We are very grateful to the teachers who are front-line educators. They make huge sacrifices to provide quality in-person education to our students. With a lot of prayers, and following the strict COVID protocol, the Lord has kept us free from an outbreak.

This is Christmas Week, and the Christmas Season is very special to all of us. I hope you have made your reservations for the Christmas Mass that you plan to attend in person. It is a season of joy and giving. This year our external Christmas celebrations might be a bit different. However, Jesus is still the “reason for the season.” He brings joy and peace. My mind flies back to the Church of the Shepherds that we visited during our pilgrimage to the Holy Land last year. This church was built in 1954 on the ruins of a 4th-Century monastery. This lovely Chapel of the Shepherds is built in the form of a tent, and its cupola—with tiny glass windows—reminds everyone of the heavens and the stars. The picture on the Christmas card that you received this year is the photo that I took of the beautiful painting found right behind the altar in this chapel.

In fact, this chapel is one of the sites traditionally believed to be identified in the gospel scene where the Angel of the Lord visited the shepherds and informed them of Jesus’ birth. “. . . and there were shepherds in that region living in the fields and keeping the night watch over their flock. The Angel of the Lord appeared to them and said, ‘Do not be afraid; for behold, I proclaim to you good news of great joy that will be for all the people. For today in the City of David, a savior has been born for you who is Christ and Lord.’”

The message of the angels is so relevant today for our times. We do not have to be in fear. We have a savior. He brings us strength and courage. His grace is sufficient for us. The Feast of Christmas offers convincing proof of God’s infinite love for us in the person of Jesus Christ. In Him is our trust, and the celebration of His birth brings us renewed hope, peace and joy. I am very grateful for all your prayers and support. **I wish you a very Blessed and Merry Christmas!**


