








From the Pastor

Stewardship 2022: *Rebuild My Church—Part IV*



God has called us to build His kingdom here on earth. All of us have a role in building up God's kingdom. He has given us gifts of time, talent and treasure to help us in that work. As baptized persons, we make up the Church. Church is not a building, but it comes from a Greek word, *Ecclesia*, which means "those called out" or "people of God." Therefore, if we make up the Church, when we say that the Church has the responsibility to spread the Gospel, to worship God, to educate children, to care for the poor and needy, then we are saying that we have the responsibility to do these things.

Our Catholic ancestors were great stewards. The evidence of their generosity is seen all over our country, including here in Bend. The Historic Church, built more than 100 years ago, is a great testimony to their generous stewardship. Stewardship is a way of living each day in gratitude for all the blessings that God has given us. We are here on earth to use God's gifts to do God's work. Giving time and talent does not excuse us from giving treasure. We can demonstrate that we put God first by making a conscious effort to make a financial gift to God first, before we pay our bills and buy the things we want.

Why does the church need your gifts? Your contributions help to pay the staff, to provide faith education, to pay the utility bills that keep the lights on, and to keep the rooms cool in summer and warm in winter. As a Church and a School, we provide a Catholic education and evangelize children and their families. We purchase many supplies needed for the office, liturgies, and sacraments—including hosts, wine,

candles, oil, prayer books, hymnals, and so on. None of these items are free. Maintenance and upkeep of our facilities is very expensive. Contact the Parish Office if you'd like to get a copy of the Church expenses to see how your contributions are spent. The church entirely depends on your weekly contribution. Your absence in the church does not bring down the expense. Our expenses have only gone up due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

There are many ways in which you can give your gift to God. Some of them are: gift of securities, a charitable gift annuity, a charitable rollover gift, a gift of a life insurance policy, an estate gift through your will, a year-end gift, single charity fund, an endowment gift to honor your loved one and so on. If you need more information on this, the office can help you.

Commitment in the area of finance is something that many of us are reluctant to make, especially during these trying circumstances. Yet, it is precisely now that we are called to *trust Him*. This is growing in discipleship: "Any one of you who does not renounce all that he has cannot be my disciple" (Luke 14:33). The path to discipleship involves placing God first in our lives. The test of our faith and trust in God is sacrifice.

The "first fruits" / "commitment" weekend was two weekends ago. I have turned in my stewardship pledge card. Have you? God bless your sacrifices on behalf of His Church. "Whoever gives one of these little ones even a cup of cold water because he is a disciple, truly I say to you, he will by no means lose his reward." (Matthew 10:42).

The Prudent Steward: Tax-Wise Giving

As the year-end approaches and you consider your 2022 financial support of the parish, see if one of the options below makes sense for you:

- **Over 70%? Make a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) from an IRA.** There is no tax on the transfer, and it counts toward the RMD. Contact your plan administrator and Deacon Steve or Jane Rude for the required parish information. Many seniors find this a great way to give—especially if they cannot itemize their deductions.
- **Give long-term appreciated stocks.** This bypasses the tax on the capital gain, and you can deduct the fair-market value of your gift if you itemize deductions. Contact your broker and Jane Rude or Deacon Steve for the required parish information.


