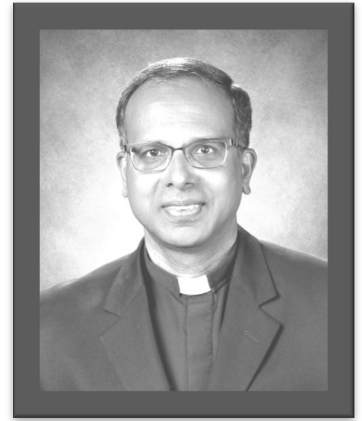

From the Pastor



Historic Church Renovation Update

Lisa Rigali sent me an email asking if I was able to come over to the Historic Church to go over the recommended vinyl flooring under the pews, the carpet for the side aisles, and the porcelain tiles for the center aisle.

I went over to the church together with Dcn. Phil on Wednesday, February 5th, to finalize the selections. This was the first time I visited the Historic Church since the last Mass I celebrated on January 5th, and my subsequent family visit to India.

When I got there, it was indeed like entering a high construction zone. The pews have been dismantled and shipped to a pew restoration company in Wisconsin. While removing them, it was noticed that they were in general in great condition. However, the sidings around the pews and a few central supports for them were in such bad condition that they cannot be repaired and restored. They will need to be replaced with new ones for an additional cost of nearly \$5,000.

Therefore, a change order has been signed to take care of that. We do have some contingency built into the Phase 2 Renovation cost for unforeseen expenses like this. Every pew will have new, light-weight kneelers because the old kneelers are beyond repair.

The carpeting has also been removed, making the wooden floor visible, which appears to be in good condition. And the Stations of the Cross have been removed from the wall for refinishing.

The renovated Sanctuary has been taped off to prevent dust from getting in. The church is now full of scaffolding from the Sanctuary to the Rose Window at the back of the choir loft.

The Rigali Studio Team had arrived on Sunday, February 2nd, and starting working on the interior of the church. Sample colors were painted on the wall for us to look at, and the team has started skim coating the walls on both sides as part of the plan.

Skim coating drywall is a technique used to create a smooth and seamless finish by applying a thin layer of joint compound. This technique is useful for covering up imperfections, resulting in a flawless final appearance. The walls are already looking amazing!

The scaffoldings have also been installed, creating an upper “floor” and providing access to the ceiling. I was able to get up there to get a closer look at it. It is a different feeling to be up so close to the ceiling—all the way from the Sanctuary to the Rose Window in the choir loft. A couple of cracks on the ceiling that were visible even from the floor have been filled in and repaired. The ceiling will be a sky blue color, and the coves on both sides of the Sanctuary will have a little darker color to give it depth.

The stained-glass window frames will receive new painting, making them very beautiful. The two-inch frame from around the stained-glass windows will receive a different color, making them very special. They have already painted a portion of a window for us to see. I can’t believe the difference that simple change has made. That is clearly a “master touch.” And that is why they are paid the “big bucks.”

The carpet and vinyl samples are also stunningly beautiful. The vinyl flooring under the pews matches the wooden sidings along the wall, and the classic style carpet along the side aisles will match the colors of the stained-glass windows.

I can’t wait for all of it to be completed. While the renovation is making progress, we are also raising funds. We have raised almost half of the funds needed. Thanks to all who are making sacrifices. Your support is a testament to your love for your faith. We will have just enough funds to pay the bill this month, which is \$150,000, but not enough to pay the March bill, which is \$200,000.

We will need to borrow money from the Diocese if we are not able to raise the funds needed to pay the March bill. There are several pews still available for sponsorship. You will be able to have your name or the name of your loved ones on the pews which will be a visible testimony of your faith.

There are also a few more Stations of the Cross and a Confessional available for sponsorship.

May the Lord reward your sacrifices and help us to bring our efforts to a fruitful completion.

— Guidelines for Lent 2025 —

Lent prepares the faithful to celebrate the Paschal Mystery of Christ’s suffering, death, and resurrection. It is a time for reflection and spiritual renewal—a time to examine one’s relationship with God and with others. Lent is also the final preparation period for catechumens seeking to be baptized at the Easter Vigil.

As Catholics, the Church calls us to a spirit of repentance and conversion—
“to turn away from sin, and to be faithful to the Gospel.”

Through our traditional practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving,
we express our conversion and prepare to renew our Baptismal promises at Easter.

Below are the Church’s definitions of “fasting and abstinence,”
as well as the obligatory minimum requirements that she asks of us.

- **Abstinence: Meat and poultry are removed from our meals—fish is acceptable.**
- **Fasting: Eat one (1) full meal and two (2) smaller meals—no snacking during the day.**
- **All Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 should fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.**
- **All Catholics 14 years and older are to abstain from meat and poultry on Ash Wednesday, all the Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday.**

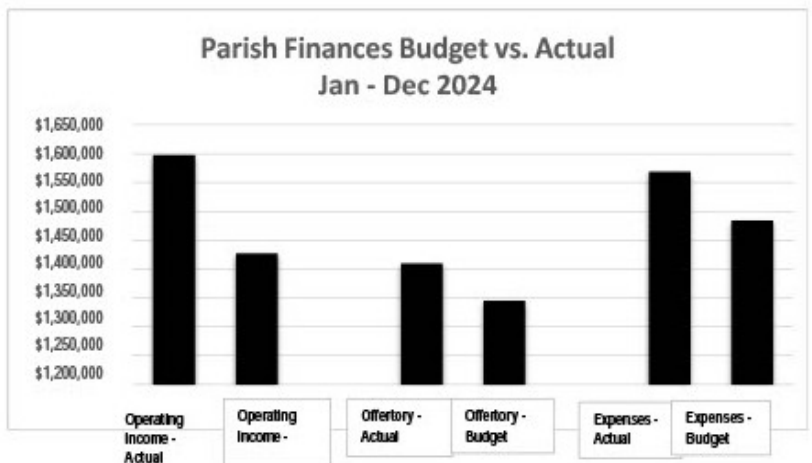
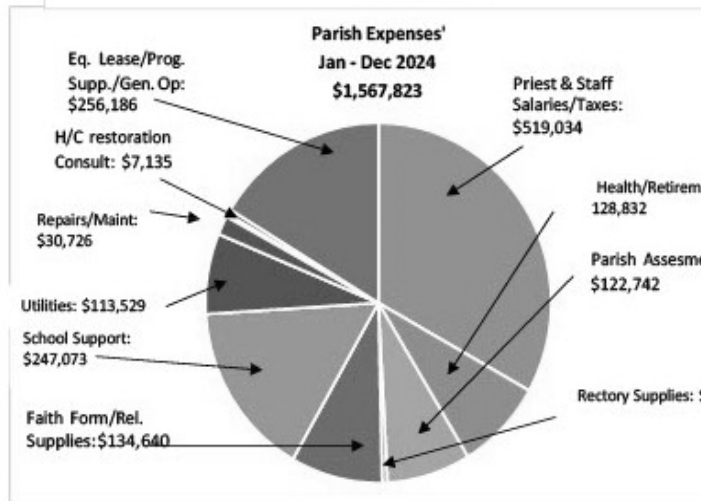
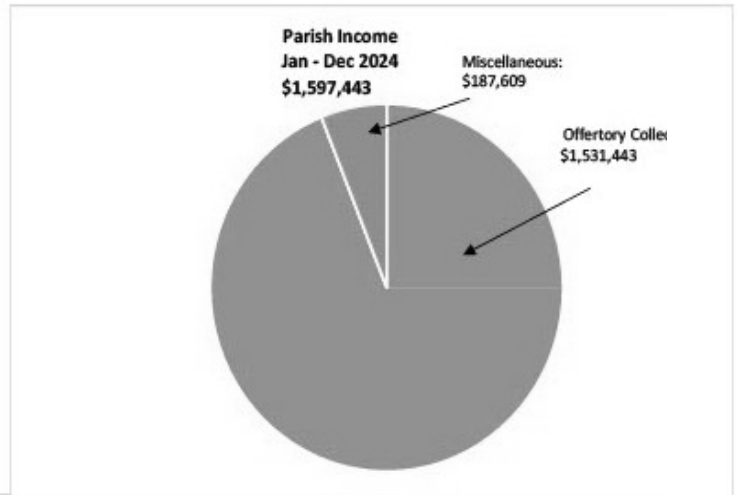
