

From the Pastor



Making Disciples: Part 1

The Catholic parish is nothing short of an outpost of the Great Commission. “Go therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you” (Matthew 28: 19-20).

The physical manifestation of this call is a parish. If so, why not make our parish the most effective outpost of that Great Commission? It doesn't matter where we live. All of us have a responsibility to spread the Gospel, evangelize and make disciples. This is our mission, and we exist for this mission. We exist to make disciples.

Jesus gave His nascent Church four tasks: go, make, baptize and teach. It is making disciples that is at the very heart of the Great Commission. It is around the making of disciples that all other missionary aspects of the Church revolve. However, it is the task that we struggle with the most.

What does it mean to make disciples? Who is a disciple? To be a disciple is to be a learner. To be a disciple of Jesus Christ is to be engaged in a lifelong process of learning from and about Jesus, the Master—Jesus, the teacher. This learning process is intentional and disciplined. To become a disciple is to commit to such a process of growth.

How many in our parish does this term honestly describe? If we have not become a disciple ourselves, how can we make disciples? By our baptism, we committed ourselves to becoming disciples and making disciples. Catechesis in Catholic circles usually means what we do with children. Learning in faith for an adult is viewed as entirely optional and non-essential. Although the laity of our Church is more educated and professional than at any other time in history, the corresponding literacy in things of faith, theology, scripture and spiritual life lags far behind.

Over the past 50 years, our society has witnessed the most accelerated social change in human history. Seventy years ago, the culture supported faith and church attendance. Demographics supported our pastoral development through the birth of children and movement of migrants. As long as we baptized and taught in our schools, we pumped out good “practicing Catholics.” In a sense, we got away from making disciples. The sexual revolution, post-modernism, materialism, relativism, individualism and all other “isms” have taken many minds and hearts from what is true and good.

Hundreds of thousands of faithful Catholics carry the enormous burden of children and grandchildren who have abandoned “the faith.” The fact is that the rules have changed, and we no longer have the cultural props we had before, and the social current has turned against us. The only solution going forward is to return to what Jesus asked of us more than 2,000 years ago: to not just make believers, or “practicing Catholics,” but to make disciples. This is the heart of the matter, and the lens through which we are to evaluate all activity of the Church, all pastoral programs, all expenditures and all use of our buildings.

The identity crisis in the Church today is not about doctrines but its mission. It is said that it's not so much that the Church of Christ has a mission, as that the mission of Christ has a Church. When the Church forgets its missionary calling, and we content ourselves with maintenance and serving ourselves, we have entered into a crisis.

To be a missionary you do not have to go to a faraway place. You can be a missionary right here. Let us focus on our mission to make disciples.¹

Cost is \$150 per family plus lodging fees for cabin, RV site, or tent site.







Guidelines for Lent 2022

Below are the definitions of the Church for "fasting and abstinence" as well as the obligatory minimum requirements that she asks of us.



- † Abstinence: Meat and poultry are removed from our meals—fish is acceptable.
- † Fasting: Eat one (1) full meal and two (2) smaller meals—no snacking during the day.
- † All Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
- † All Catholics 14 years and older are to abstain from meat and poultry on Ash Wednesday, all the Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday.


Slow Down!

Lenten Devotional Aids






