From the Pastor

Splendid India Tour 2

Continuing on my recent tour of India, we took a flight to Kochi and were met by our guide who drove us to the hotel. We checked-in, had dinner, and went to rest after a long day of travel. The next morning we began the city tour with a visit to St. Francis Church located in Fort Kochi. Originally built in 1503, it is one of the oldest European churches in India and has historical significance as a witness to the European colonial ambitions in the subcontinent.

The Portuguese explorer, Vasco da Gama, died in Kochi in 1524 when he was on his third visit to India. His body was originally buried in this church, but after 14 years, his remains were relocated to Lisbon and are now interred at Jerónimos Monastery. The church owes its origin to the Portuguese Franciscan Friars who reached Kochi along with Pedro Alvarez Cabral. The church, made of wood and mud, was situated in the middle of the fort that had been constructed by the Portuguese and witnessed various European invasions of Kochi.

During an invasion in 1663, it became a Dutch possession, and it was converted into a Protestant church. Then in 1804, the Dutch surrendered it to the Anglican Church following the British invasion of Kochi in 1795. Finally, the Church of South India (CSI) took over the administration and management of it since 1949.

After our visit to the church, we went to see the Chinese fishing nets, where they demonstrated the use these nets to fish. Most of us helped to pull one of the nets up, but there was only a couple of tiny fish caught in it. Viewing these nets offers a marvelous scenic vista along the backwaters of Kerala. It is believed that traders from the court of the Chinese ruler Kublai Khan introduced the nets here. Oddly, these nets are found only in Kochi, outside of China! Many fishermen earn their living fishing with these massive nets, and a whole stretch of the coast along Fort Kochi and Vypeen are dotted with them.

From there we walked on over to the only active synagogue in South India—Paradesi Synagogue. It is the oldest one in India, located in Kochi, in the State of Kerala. It was one of the traditional houses of worship of the Jews. It stands as a white-walled rectangular building with a tiled roof and wrought-iron gates decorated with the Star of David. It also has a Dutch-style clock tower with four clocks featuring four dif-

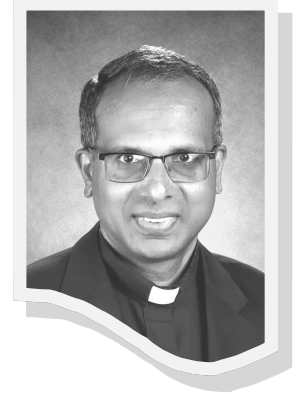
ferent numeral styles: Hebrew, Roman, Malayalam, and Arabic.

The synagogue houses gold and silver decorated Torah scrolls, an intricately carved teak ark, a rug that was a gift from the Ethiopian Emperor Haile Selassie I, paintings portraying Jewish history, Belgian crystal chandeliers, and decorative lamps in silver, brass, and glass. A unique feature is the hand-painted tiles that pave the floor, which were brought from China. There are only a very few Jews left in Kochi, and those attending the service that day were mostly visitors.

From there we made our way to the Santa Cruz Cathedral Basilica in Fort Kochi. It is one of the eight Basilicas in India. This heritage edifice of Kerala is also one of the finest and imposing churches in India. Located close to the renowned St. Francis Church, this basilica serves as the Cathedral Church of the Diocese of Cochin, the second oldest Diocese of India.

The history of Santa Cruz Cathedral Basilica dates back to the 16th Century and begins with the arrival of Portuguese missionaries in 1500 CE. The construction works started when the first Portuguese Viceroy Dom Francisco de Almeida got permission from the Cochin Raja to build a church. The foundation stone was laid on May 3, 1505. This amazing construction has two lofty spires that welcome all even from a distance. The exterior is white-washed and astonishingly bright, and the interior is pastel-colored. The interior of the church has Gothic-style architecture with its overwhelming arches and an awe-inspiring altar. The ceilings of the church are adorned with paintings that depict scenes from the *Via Crucis* of Christ. The beautiful stained-glass windows are another attraction. In 1984 Pope John Paul II raised the status of Santa Cruz Cathedral to Basilica for its antiquity, artistic dignity, and historical importance.

Then we walked over to Dhobi Khana, the origins of which lie in the colonial period, when British officers brought many Tamil villagers to Kochi to work as “washer men.” This Tamil community was first organized in the 1920s and has retained its cohesive identity over the years. These washer men offer laundry services to houses, hospitals, hotels, hostels, and some government firms. All clothes are hand washed and dried in the open and pressed to look perfect.

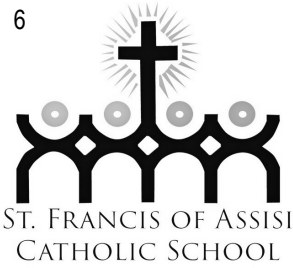

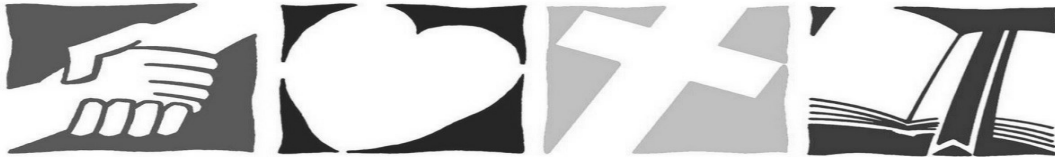


