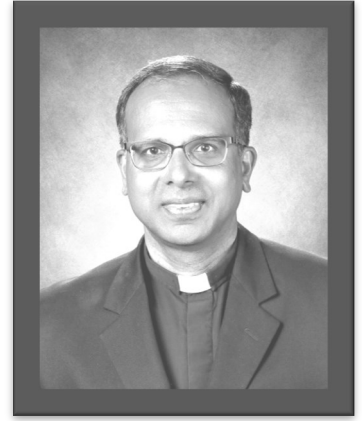

D From the Pastor



Reflections on the Family Visit

I am happy to be back after being away on a family visit to India. I want to thank you for all your prayers. The trip was great. The flights were mostly on time, and there were no disruptive delays. However, I now realize that I do not enjoy long flights anymore. The 16-hour, non-stop flight from San Francisco to Doha in Qatar was gruesome in an economy seat. Maybe I'm getting older?

The weather was great. It was in the 70s at night, and soon after the sun rose, the temperature shot up to the 80s and lower 90s—but with 70 percent humidity. While there, I got to visit with all my siblings and many members of the family. Unfortunately, a few nephews and nieces couldn't make it.

My little town in the State of Kerala, India, is on the Malabar Coast, and it is surrounded by water and rice fields.

My time with the family was productively spent. I officiated at three weddings, one baptism, and two death anniversary remembrance Masses. I also attended the Silver Jubilee Ordination of a priest friend.

Unexpectedly, I was also called to officiate at two funerals. One was for a classmate of mine who passed away of a heart attack at the age of 53, and the other was for the husband of my cousin who has been ailing and passed away at 67 years old.

These events brought many members of the family together, giving opportunities to see and visit with them. Though I had to travel to these events, I didn't have to travel to visit family and friends.

However, I did travel to visit a few relatives of mine who are sick, homebound, and cannot travel anymore. And I also traveled to Bhopal, another state and town in India, to visit with Fr. Joseph, my priest cousin, and Br. Monachan, a religious brother, who is also a cousin. They have been inviting me to visit them for some time. And so this time, because they couldn't make it to any of those family events, I went to their place and spent three days with them. Both of them are principals of schools with more than 3,400 students in each school.

During this family visit, I also spent some quality time with the "Miracle Twins," the first children of my brother after 28 years of their marriage. Anna is

very outgoing. She knows no strangers, only friends, and she needs no permission to get into the lap or the arms of anyone. Maria, however, watches from afar, shy and wondering who the strangers might be. But then she warms up in a few minutes. Although they are twins, they are very different in their looks and in their interests. While Anna's favorite food is chicken and beef, Maria's favorite food is rice and curry.

They go to a convent school, and both of them love school. It is the only thing of interest they have in common. The school bus picks them up at 9 a.m. and drops them back at 3 p.m. They turned 4 years old on January 24th, and they are the youngest in the class. However, Maria keeps up with her classmates and gets 1st in tests, while Anna gets 1st in "socialization." There are 24 students in their class, and Anna knows everyone by name, and more than just their names.

Both of them talk a lot, and they ask lots of questions. I was also surprised at how much homework they have every day. The first thing Maria does after coming home from school is to do her homework. She doesn't need to be told most of the time. However, Anna hates to do her homework. She drinks her glass of milk and goes to sleep soon after coming from school. Then she has to be literally dragged to get her homework done. In her case, her Mom deserves an A+ in completing homework.

They are learning two languages—Malayalam, the local language—and English. They have homework on writing the alphabets, numbers, days and months in both languages.

After spending a few days with the twins, I have grown in my appreciation of parents who do a lot to bring up children in God's ways—whether that is getting them ready for church or school—or teaching them their prayers.

All of us, particularly children, belong to God. Church is where they belong. We have many families with children in our parish. My deep appreciation is for all you do for your children. After all, it is the family that makes up the foundation of the Church.

National Marriage Week

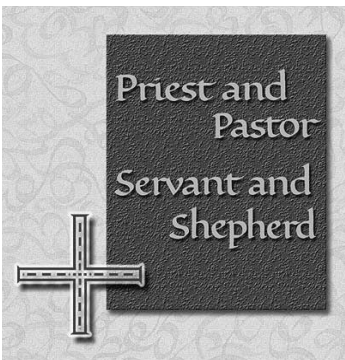
