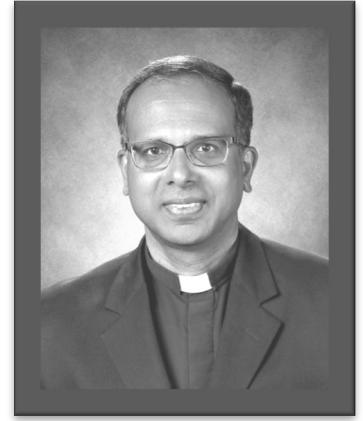

From the

Jubilee Year 2025

Pope Francis has proposed that 2024 should be marked as a year dedicated to prayer in preparation for the Jubilee Year 2025. Dioceses and parishes are invited to promote initiatives to remind people of the centrality of both individual prayer and community prayer. **Bishop Cary** opened the Jubilee Year for the Diocese of Baker on December 29th at the Cathedral Church in Baker City.

Stay tuned for more information on the diocesan celebration of the Jubilee Year. And on the weekend of **January 18–19**, you will have an opportunity to listen to Fr. Richard Roemer, who will speak on the Jubilee Year at all the Masses.

In 1300, **Pope Boniface VIII** called the first Jubilee, also known as a “Holy Year,” because it is a time in which God’s holiness transforms us. The frequency of Holy Years has changed over time: at first, they were celebrated every 100 years. Later, in 1343, **Pope Clement VI** reduced the gap between Jubilees to every 50 years, and in 1470, **Pope Paul II** made it every 25 years.

The most recent ordinary jubilee took place in the year 2000, as the world and the Catholic Church prepared to enter the new millennium. There have also been “extraordinary” Holy Years. For example, in 1933, **Pope Pius XI** chose to commemorate the 1900th anniversary of the Redemption, and in 2015, **Pope Francis** proclaimed the Year of Mercy as an extraordinary jubilee.

The way in which Jubilee Years are marked has also changed through the centuries. Originally, the Holy Year consisted of a pilgrimage to the Roman Basilicas of St. Peter and St. Paul. Later, other signs were added, such as the Holy Door. By participating in the Holy Year Pilgrimages, one is granted a plenary indulgence. Following the extraordinary 2015 Holy Year of

Mercy instigated by **Pope Francis**, this Jubilee Year will take place in line with the norm of leaving a 25-year gap between each one.

The Jubilee Year is a special year of grace, in which the Church offers the faithful the possibility of obtaining a plenary indulgence. Traditionally, it begins just before Christmas and ends on the Epiphany of the following year. The Pope inaugurated the Jubilee Year on December 24th, with the rite of the opening of the Holy Door in St. Peter’s Basilica. After that, the Holy Doors of the other papal basilicas—St. John Lateran, St. Paul Outside the Walls, and St. Mary Major—are opened and will remain so until the end of the Jubilee Year.

It is keeping this Jubilee Year in mind that I have put together the “Shrines of Italy Pilgrimage,” from **Tuesday, May 6th, through Saturday, May 17th of 2025**. We will be visiting all of the basilicas mentioned above, and we will have the unique opportunity to walk through the Holy Doors.

Speaking after he had an audience with **Pope Francis on January 3, 2024**, **Archbishop Rino Fisichella** said that during the meeting, the Pope approved the motto proposed for the upcoming Jubilee Year—a motto he said—“That can be summed up in two words: Pilgrims of Hope.”

Archbishop Fisichella explained that, like for any motto, it attempts to condense the meaning of the entire Jubilee journey. He notes that the chosen words—pilgrims and hope—both represent key themes of **Pope Francis’** pontificate: “This Jubilee can contribute greatly to restoring a climate of hope and trust as a prelude to the renewal and rebirth that we so urgently desire; that is why I have chosen as the motto of the Jubilee, Pilgrims of Hope.” —**Pope Francis**

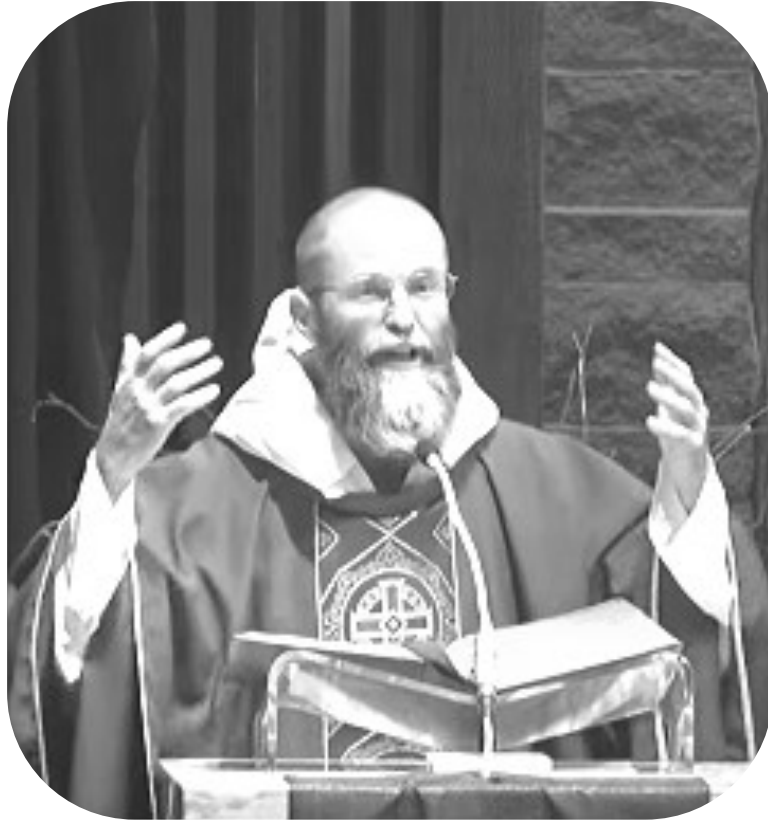
