

From the Pastor



Alpha: Bringing the Mission to the Center of Our Church's Life and Activities—Part 3

Evangelization Alpha is a tool to introduce people to an initial proclamation of the good news of Jesus Christ—the kerygma. As Pope Francis says, “Nothing is more solid, profound, secure, meaningful, and wisdom-filled than that initial proclamation” (EG, 165).

Encounter Alpha takes people on a journey often leading to a personal encounter with Jesus Christ. It enables people to ask their questions, share ideas, build friendships, and experience the love of God through the power of the Holy Spirit.

Everyone Alpha is for everyone: all backgrounds, all contexts, all ages. Alpha is particularly attracting many young people who are asking the question, “Is there more to life than this?”

Alpha is not meant to bring people all the way to a fullness of the understanding of the Catholic Faith. It is after all, Alpha, the beginning. It is to lead people toward an ongoing journey of conversion after Alpha. It could be involving yourself in a small group, taking an active part in one or more ministries at the Church, reaching out to the needy, etc. Alpha is only the beginning of a life-long journey!

“Alpha is one of the best things happening in the Church today. For so many parishes, there is no event or program that we can be free to invite people to. But Alpha for Catholics gives us the chance to be the kind of mis-

sionary disciples that God has called us all to be. If any parish is looking for a place to be welcoming and engaging, they must be offering Alpha for Catholics” (Fr. Mike Schmitz).

“Alpha lit a spark of faith that has grown into a fire. . . . I began a personal relationship with God, which has been necessary for personal transformation. I am more patient, more kind, more tolerant, and especially more interested in how I can help others. Prior to Alpha, I attended Sunday Mass about 75 percent of the time, but I was asleep in the pew. It was a duty I inherited. After Alpha, I was drawn to Mass and Confession as never before. Now I attend Mass a few times a week and Confession very frequently. I have been a small-group leader for 14 Alphas in parish settings and in the workplace. My passion to tell others the good news propels me forward, and I am not afraid to lead, guide, and instruct. The Holy Spirit is my mentor and coach” (Pauline Maher, a participant of Alpha).

“I didn’t know what to expect when I was invited, and I went from one surprise to another. The other guests had the same questions that I did, and I was really impressed by how freely they shared. I never felt judged, and that feels like such a change. Alpha was a foundation for the rest of my life” (Yann, a student).

“Alpha is without doubt a great experience of New Evangelization” (Archbishop Rino Fisichella, President of the Pontifical Council for Promoting the New Evangelization).



- ♦ Walk with Jesus as he is crucified and resurrected for our salvation.


