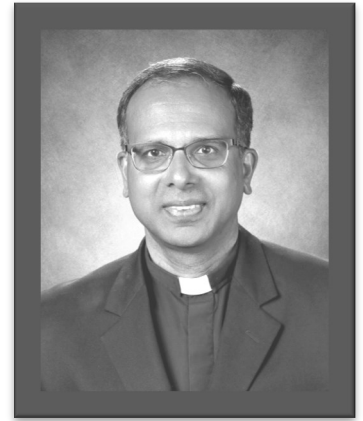

From the Pastor



Historic Church Renovation Update

The Historic Church will be closed after the 4:30 p.m. Mass on January 5th for renovation and restoration.

The week of January 6th will be spent moving stuff and clearing the church interior before the crew from Rigali Studios arrives on January 13th. There will be volunteers moving items and clearing the space on Tuesday and Wednesday, January 7th and 8th. All those who can help are welcome to come to help at 9 a.m. The chairs need to be moved, the piano needs to be secured, the pipes of the organ need to be removed and secured, the narthex, the choir loft, and the sanctuary all need to be cleared.

When the renovation crew arrives from Chicago on January 13th, they will cover and secure items in the sanctuary such as the statues, altar, ambo and communion rail. They will remove the pews and the Stations of the Cross and truck them to the studio in Chicago.

The pews are in good condition and, therefore, they will be refinished. New kneelers will be installed on all of the pews because the current kneelers are in bad condition. They are the original pews, and we want to preserve them. We still have several pews and Stations of the Cross available for sponsorship with naming opportunities. This is a great opportunity to have your name or the names of your loved ones on one or more of the pews. I am hoping that several more will consider sponsoring pews and the Stations of the Cross.

We have so far raised a little over 40% of the total goal of \$1.3 million needed for the renovation including the seed money. I usually like to have 70% of the goal in hand before the work begins, and I hope that we can get to about 70% of the money needed by the end of January and have the rest by the end of April so that we will not have to borrow any money and go into debt. We sacrificed so much to get out of the debt created by building the 27th Street Church. It's a testimony to your incredible generosity. Thanks to all who have supported this renovation effort and who continue to do so.

It will be difficult to have the Historic Church reopened by Easter. Our Bishop will be away at the

Cathedral in Baker City for Holy Week services and doing confirmations in the northern part of the diocese the week after Easter. We should be able to have the blessing and the reopening soon after that.

This Christmas drew a large crowd to the Historic Church for the Masses at 5 p.m. and 10 p.m. I am really humbled by the very encouraging comments of visitors to the Historic Church on the beautiful renovation that we have already completed. It's something each of us can take pride in. It is not only a testimony to the beauty of our Catholic faith but also of our commitment to future generations. They, too, will have an opportunity to make sacrifices when it is their time. It is the legacy we leave, not only for the Catholic community, but also to the Bend community.

The November musical concert was a great time when we saw many people of the community joining us to listen to the wonderful musical performance at the Historic Church. The beauty of the church shows the beauty of our faith. The solidity of the church shows the solidity of Catholic Faith. The community is so lucky to have something like this here in Bend.

We want to make sure that the church is here for generations to come, bringing people faith and hope. The presence of the church is a constant reminder—to all—of God dwelling in the midst of His people. The previous generation built the Church, and now it's our turn to make sure it's here for the next generation.

In a recent article in the *National Catholic Register*, Timothy O'Donnell, President of Christendom College said:

“One of the greatest glories of the Middle Ages was the advent of Gothic architecture. With high pointed arches and stained-glass windows that flooded cathedrals with ethereal light, this architectural style lifted the heart and mind upwards towards contemplation of God. Now, in an era that can truly be described as another Dark Ages, where truth is stifled and Christ is marginalized, a return to beautiful architecture that raises one's eyes and soul to God is not just important, but also necessary.”
