

# **Historic Church Renovation**—Part II

Continuing with the update of the Historic Church renovation:

- ► The Communion rail has been installed, which adds to the beauty and fervor of the church, reminding us all of the sacredness of what we celebrate—the Eucharist.
- ► The artwork on all the items in the sanctuary is very special and awe inspiring.
- ► The statues of Mary and St. Francis are back after being worked on in the studio in Chicago.
- The remainder of the stained-glass windows and statues will arrive in March.
- ► New pedestals have been built on the sanctuary wall on which to place the statues, instead of on stands on the floor.
- ► The sanctuary is now ADA compliant.
- ► The piano will not be in the sanctuary but on the floor—level with the rest of the church.
- ► The sound technicians are in the process of installing the new sound system.
- The sacristy floor has been stripped of the carpet flooring, and new flooring and cabinets will need to be installed.

We placed the order for the new HVAC over nine months ago. However, it will not be here until April, partially because it had to be custom-designed and custom-made in order to go through the basement door and fit in the basement. The new HVAC will also take up most of the space in the basement.

Several years ago when the front altar that weighed over 2,600 pounds was installed, they had to shore up the basement to support the altar. Now that has to be removed to house the HVAC. However, a new support has to be designed to take on the weight of everything in the new sanctuary, including the tiled floor, new altar, new credence tables, etc.

Then while inspecting the basement, it was also noticed that the basement had damages and needed work to make it structurally sound. This structural and seismic upgrade of the basement is in the "design phase" at this time. It will then need to go through the "permit process," and then the work can begin. This has added a \$200,000 unexpected expense to the total project.

Also, my original plan was to reuse the old items of furniture in the sanctuary. However, now that the sanctuary has been completely renovated, the old furniture does not tie in with everything else there. Thus, Rigali Studios has been asked to design and build a new set of furnishings that are needed now:

- ► One (1) Presider Chair
- ► Two (2) Deacon Chairs, and
- ► Four (4) Acolyte / Altar Server Chairs

These are available for sponsorship, and I hope some of you will sponsor them. Please contact Dcn. Phil if you would like to do so.

The exterior and sanctuary lighting upgrades and the installation of security cameras will be done in early Spring. Thanks to all your incredible generosity, we are only short \$300,000 to complete this phase of the renovation.

The renovation of the nave is Phase II of the project. This consists of refinishing the pews, replacing the kneelers, replacing the flooring, refinishing the stations, skim coating the walls, painting the ceiling, refinishing every piece of wood in the nave, and installing new lighting. This phase will cost about \$1.2 million. I would love to complete this as well, if that is God's plan. However, at this time we do not have the funds, and we will not begin this phase until we have at least 70 percent of the funds in hand.

We hope to have an Open House sometime in March or April to facilitate viewing of the work already done. Anyone interested will be able to go inside to have a "sneak peek" of the work and talk to the workers. A beautiful church is a testimony to the beauty of faith. Thanks for your continued generous support, and please keep all of us in your prayers!


