

From the Pastor



Alpha: Bringing the Mission to the Center of Our Church's Life and Activities—Part 2

Alpha is the evangelization tool we plan to use in our parish to deepen our own faith and to reach out to those who are not back to Church yet now that all the restrictions are lifted and to evangelize the unchurched. It is now used in more than 100 countries and over 1.5 million people have experienced Alpha. “One of the advantages of Alpha is that it focuses on the kerygma. In the ancient church, there was a clear distinction between the kerygma and the Didaché, the catechesis. The kerygma was the starting point of faith, and the catechesis had to form the faith, but faith in itself blossoms only by hearing the kerygma” (*Fr. Raniero Cantalamessa*).

Using Alpha, we hope to deepen our faith and evangelize by:

1. Creating a Culture of Invitation and Hospitality within our community

Is St. Francis an inviting community? Are we an evangelizing community? How many of you have invited someone to go to Church with you to a Mass, to a social gathering, to a Bible study, etc. in the past three months? Have you talked to someone about Jesus Christ or your faith in the past month?

“An evangelizing community knows that the Lord has taken the initiative. He has loved us first (cf. 1 John 4:19), and therefore we can move forward, boldly take the initiative, go out to others, seek those who have fallen away, stand at the crossroads, and welcome the outcast” (EG, 24).

Alpha helps the parish to become an evangelizing community. Those who have experienced Alpha naturally want to invite their friends to the next Alpha. The Alpha small groups help the parish remember the importance of welcome and hospitality for those who come to explore life and faith.

2. Creating a Culture of Encounter

“Open yourselves docilely to the gifts of the Spirit! Accept gratefully and obediently the charisms which the Spirit never ceases to bestow on us! Do not forget that every charism is given for the common good; that is, for the benefit of the whole Church” (*St. John Paul II, Pentecost 1998*).

Alpha helps the parish to foster a personal encounter and relationship with Jesus through the power and ministry of the Holy Spirit. Through the simple model used in Alpha for prayer ministry, people learn how to pray for one another, and it becomes a normal part of life in the parish.

3. Creating a Culture of Missionary Discipleship

“Every Christian is a missionary to the extent that he or she has encountered the love of God in Christ Jesus” (EG, 120). Alpha engages lay people in the life and mission of the Church. With the blessing of the pastor, a core team takes ownership and hosts Alpha in the parish. Often, guests who have experienced Alpha go on to become effective and confident evangelizers themselves as they share the impact that their encounter and relationship with Jesus has had on their lives.

I encourage everyone to read the book, *Divine Renovation*, by Fr. James Mallon: “The impact of running Alpha is that the laity can now engage in evangelization. Before, we felt a bit timid about sharing Jesus with others, but Alpha has given us boldness.”

We have been praying for those whose names are in the basket. I had asked you to identify and pray for those who you want to invite. We begin the Alpha on January 18th. Please invite your friends, co-workers, and neighbors. Let us get serious about our Mission to evangelize.


Does your marriage need a tune up? Or even a major overhaul? Sometimes marriages can run along just fine, and then things change. They may need your time and attention.





ST. FRANCIS SCHOOL NEWS

The mission of Saint Francis of Assisi Catholic School is to educate the whole child in a Christ-centered community that values service, leadership, and academic excellence.

The vision of our school is to inspire academic scholars motivated to serve and lead the world with Faith and moral character.

What do teachers at St. Francis School believe about teaching and learning?

St. Francis teachers believe that we are called to serve students by setting examples of leadership and growth with loving guidance so that they know they are loved. We strive to improve on our teaching practice continually to provide differentiations through small, attainable goals so that our students can meet or exceed their grade-level standards. We believe that God made every child able to learn, and that they learn by doing. We actively look for signs of growth and give constant feedback. We strive to effectively communicate successes, struggles, and goals with parents as the primary teachers of their children.

As a Catholic faith-based institution, we believe that human beings were created to know, to love and to serve God. Our faith is integrated into our teaching and learning—not just learning the church doctrine—but also with the utmost respect for a child’s innocence and curiosity in approaching the world around us. We believe that children experience grace in the gifts of nature, discover truths in the patterns that flow from seasons and scientific exploration, and can serve our Lord by protecting life in all its stages.

Saint Francis teachers believe that every child has the passion, potential, and intrinsic motivation to learn. We believe it is our God-given gift to have a natural curiosity about the world. We believe every child needs constant feedback, respect, and to know their

value to be able to put forth their best effort and be looking for success. We believe the required curriculum is attainable and that students need to be given multiple opportunities to demonstrate that they are retaining that knowledge.

The expectation of learners at St. Francis of Assisi Catholic School is that our students will be successful because they are intrinsically motivated to engage in learning to the best of their ability. We expect every student to strive to improve, show growth, and be resilient, with the understanding that learning requires effort and practice. We encourage every student to be a leader by knowing the reasonable expectations and holding themselves accountable to meeting or exceeding them.

The way that St. Francis of Assisi Catholic School teachers achieve their mission and vision is by addressing the needs of the whole child, creating multiple avenues for learning the subject matter, and providing multiple opportunities for the child to show mastery of the content. This includes Integrated lessons, sensory experiences, technology-based lessons, muscle memory and recall techniques, activating prior knowledge, constructing connections between life experiences and curriculum, and direct instruction. The use of formative and summative assessments guide the teachers in decision making and providing feedback.






