D From the Pastor



Doing the Will of the Father

I don't know if you ever wonder if you are doing the will of the Father like Jesus did. I have that question as a constant in my daily life. When I was in formation to become a priest, I wrote an essay responding to that question. I hope this can help you as it has helped me in my “day by day.”

In Catholic teaching, doing the will of the Father is at the very heart of Christian discipleship. It is not merely about following rules or external obligations, but about aligning one's heart, mind, and actions with God's loving plan. Jesus Himself said, “My food is to do the will of the one who sent me” (John 4:34), revealing that the Father's will was His sustenance and mission. For Catholics, then, to do the will of the Father means to imitate Christ in obedience, love, and trust.

The will of the Father is revealed most clearly in Scripture, in the life and teachings of Jesus, and through the guidance of the Church. Catholics believe that God desires all people to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth (cf. I Timothy 2:4). This divine will is not forced upon humanity but offered as an invitation. Responding to it involves daily decisions to love God above all things and to love one's

neighbor as oneself. The Ten Commandments, the Beatitudes, and the moral teachings of the Church all help the faithful discern what it means to live according to God's will.

Moreover, the will of the Father often involves carrying one's cross. Jesus taught that those who wish to follow Him must deny themselves and take up their cross daily (Luke 9:23). This includes enduring suffering with faith, forgiving others, seeking justice, and serving the poor. Doing the will of the Father is not always easy, but it leads to true freedom and peace because it reflects our created purpose: to know, love, and serve God in this life and be happy with Him forever in the next.

Ultimately, doing the will of the Father is not about perfection, but about a sincere and persevering relationship with God. It is the path to holiness and eternal life. As Jesus said in Matthew 7:21, “Not everyone who says to me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only the one who does the will of my Father in heaven.” This call challenges every Catholic to live their faith authentically, with humility and love, seeking God's will in all things.
