From the Pastor



A Hearty Welcome to Fr. Rogatian Urassa

Iwould like to extend a very warm welcome to **Fr. Roga** (as he loves to be called) to St. Francis. Fr. Roga was born in the Rombo District of the Kilimanjaro region in Northern Tanzania in 1954. He graduated from St. James Junior Seminary in Philosophy and then graduated in Theology from St. Augustine's Major Seminary, which is located near the Benedictine Monastery in Southern Tanzania. He was ordained a priest on November 20, 1983 at Christ the King Cathedral in the Diocese of Moshi, Tanzania, for the Holy Spirit Fathers—a missionary order more formally known as the Apostolic Life Community of Priests in the Opus Spiritus Sancti (ALCP/OSS). He worked in different ministries, mainly as a Pastor in parochial territories in three dioceses of Tanzania before moving to the United States.

Fr. Roga worked in the Diocese of Boise, Idaho, for five years—from 1998 to October 2003—when his application was accepted to join the Diocese of Baker. He worked in Boardman, Oregon, at Our Lady of Guadalupe Parish as Administrator from October, 2003 to June 4, 2004, after which he became the Pastor of the Sacred Heart Church in Klamath Falls—until this transfer to St. Francis. Fr. Roga spent 19 years as the Pastor of Sacred Heart Church in Klamath Falls. He had been there even before I got to this diocese in 2007. Wow!

The first church in Klamath Falls was built in 1905 and dedicated to the Sacred Heart. In 1910, the church was enlarged and a room for the priest was added. A barn on the property housed the priest's horse. In 1916, property was purchased at 8th and High Streets, and the church was moved to its current location. A parish hall was built next to the church, where the present church offices are located. Due to the coming of the railroad and expansion of the lumber industry, a drive for a new church and

rectory began in 1928.

Construction started in June of 1929 and was completed in October of that same year.

A small school was started in 1917 which was staffed by the Sisters of Charity of Nazareth, Kentucky. They were replaced in 1924 by the Sisters of St. Francis. As years went by, the Sisters of St. Francis had fewer and fewer candidates and, in 1980, they deeded the school and land to the Diocese of Baker. The Sisters left in 1988, and the high school was closed. June of 1993 brought the complete closing of the Sacred Heart School due to financial woes and a declining enrollment. Hundreds of children from the Klamath River Basin attended the school during its 76 years of operation.

On September 20, 1993, Klamath Falls endured two earthquakes of magnitude 5.9 and 6.0. The older part of the school received major damage and was subsequently razed. Two of the existing buildings received only minor damage. The church also suffered nearly a quarter of a million dollars in damage. The bell tower was reinforced with large steel beams, and geothermal heat was installed.

I am sure it was a hard change for Fr. Roga to leave Sacred Heart Church after being there for 19 years. But we are delighted to have him! Fr. Roga speaks English and Spanish in addition to his original languages: Kichaga and the regional language of Swahili spoken in East Africa. He is a naturalized U.S. citizen and a member of the Diocese of Baker.

In his spare time, he enjoys watching sports (especially soccer, basketball, golf, tennis, and baseball). He also enjoys fishing, golfing, and taking care of his flower garden. We warmly welcome Fr. Roga to St. Francis Parish family!

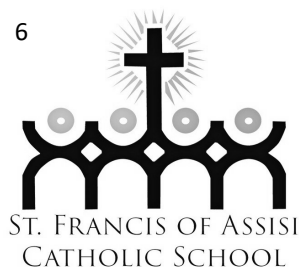
