

Historic Church Renovation Update



ly for renovation and restoration on July 3rd after years of planning and fundraising. I would like to give you an update on what has been done so far. On June 17th, some members of our parish—led by the Knights of Columbus—cleaned up the basement of the church.

It took several hours to clean out everything because only one person at a time could get up and down the stairwell. But many helping hands made the work lighter.

There were things that were many years old that had to be removed, and several pieces of wood were taken home by some to work with. Most of the things were just junk, though, that went to the landfill. As you very well know, cleaning basements is always fun! ©

Then on July 3rd, a few volunteers and several Knights of Columbus members cleaned out the sanctuary of the church. Everything except the altar was removed to prepare the space for the abatement team to work without hindrance. The altar is solid marble and weighs more than 2,100 pounds. It might need a moving company to move it!

Several pieces of furniture from the sanctuary are now stored in the old rectory. As dust gets into everything, we had to move all the vestments to the old rectory as well. A couple of statues that were on pedestals on the carpet were moved into the confessionals for safe keeping—although they do not need to go to confession any more. All the other statues will be taken to the Daprato Rigali Studio to be refinished.

The piano was moved out into the nave and carefully covered up. The organ in the choir loft has been draped professionally to make sure that no pipes are damaged—and no dust gets in. The chairs from both side aisles were stacked up and covered in the narthex of the church. Getting the chairs away from the aisles is necessary to set up scaffoldings to access the stained-glass windows.

Because no renovation is planned for the nave, the pews have been draped to prevent dust or any other damage.

I would like to thank the Knights and all of the volunteers who helped us to get the spaces ready for renovation. May the Lord bless your sacrifices!

On July 17th, the abatement team came in to get the asbestos removed from under the carpet in the sanctuary area and the basement. They had to have special gear to do the work. They worked the whole week from July 17th to July 21st to get the work done. Then the Daprato Rigali team began to remove the stained-glass windows on July 25th and transport them to the Studio in Chicago. They will also transport the ambo and the statues.

I am so excited that the renovation is underway, and I hope to keep you updated on the progress. You might have received a letter from me by now, asking for your support to complete this project. Only 22% of the total number of households have made a pledge or a donation to the project. If you have pledged, you will have received an update on your pledge with my letter. Thank you for your participation.

If you have not donated toward this restoration project, you would have received a letter with a pledge card. We need your support to complete the project. Several items are still available for sponsorship, including the stained-glass windows. This is the last chance, too, for a naming opportunity before the windows are restored.

Please consider making a donation to this project. We welcome all donations large and small. As you know, the total cost went up from \$1.5 million to \$1.9 million due to inflation and supply-chain constraints. We still need to raise \$500,000 before the completion of this project. Thanks for your sacrifice to make the house of God a beautiful and welcoming place for generations to come.






