



From the Pastor



Alpha: Bringing the Mission to the Center of Our Church's Life and Activities—Part 1

What is our Mission? One of the important priorities for our parish that I set forth in my Vision 2025 is evangelization. As a Church community, we exist to evangelize. Our primary mission is to make disciples for Christ. That was the final wish and command that Jesus left with his disciples before he ascended into heaven:

“Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you” (Matthew 28:19).

“We cannot forget that evangelization is first and foremost about preaching the Gospel to those who do not know Jesus Christ. . . . Many of them are quietly seeking God, led by a yearning to see His face, even in countries of ancient Christian tradition. All of them have a right to receive the Gospel. Christians have the duty to proclaim the Gospel without excluding anyone” (*Pope Francis, Evangelii Gaudium, 15*).

Why Evangelize? “For the disciple of Christ to evangelize is an obligation of love” (*St. John Paul II*). We need to become more and more an evangelizing community here in Bend. There are so many in town who do not know of Christ. We have a mission to reach out to them while deepening our own faith. Evangelization needs to take priority, and everything we do should be centered on deepening our own faith and bringing others to Christ.

Ever since the pandemic started, a small group of us led by Deacon Steve met to pray and to discern a path to become a strong evangelizing community. We have been evaluating various evangelization tools that are available to us. This small group has met numerous times. The tool that we would like to use in our parish to advance in our Mission to evangelize is Alpha. This small group has spent numerous hours going over this wonderful tool of evangelization.

Someone from the group will contact you to invite you to be part of the larger team.

What is Alpha? Alpha is the basic message of Jesus Christ. It is a series of sessions exploring the Christian faith, typically running over 11 weeks. Each talk looks at a different question around faith and is designed to create conversation. Alpha is run all around the globe, and everyone is welcome. Alpha runs all around the world in cafés, churches, universities, homes, bars—you name it. No two Alphas look the same, but they have three key things in common: food, a talk, and good conversation.

Who is Alpha's Audience? Alpha is for everyone but primarily for the unchurched, those who are not Christian, and those who have little or no familiarity with Jesus. But we need you to reach out to them and accompany them to this. Alpha is a place where anyone is welcome to come with their questions and concerns, regardless of their commitment level to the Church or to God. Because of this, some of us may feel that the concepts are more introductory than you need. If you are one of them, consider this a refresher for your heart as well as your head.

Is it for me? The truth is that many Catholics have been “sacramentalized” without ever having been evangelized. Many Catholics today are interested in checking off the list of sacraments they have received and that their children have received without being truly evangelized or having had a personal encounter with Christ. Alpha is the perfect opportunity for an encounter with Christ. The content of Alpha never changes, but the context in which it runs is constantly changing. Alpha is run throughout the world by Christians of all traditions, providing a common expression of “proclamation, service and witness” (*EG, 246*).

Official Announcement from Bishop Liam Cary

On **Friday, June 25th**, Gov. Kate Brown announced that the COVID-19 restrictions will end when the State achieves a 70%, first-dose, adult vaccination rate—or on **Wednesday, June 30th**, whichever comes first.

In light of this development, **I hereby withdraw the general dispensation from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation.**

The obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation is reinstated in the Diocese of Baker this weekend,

July 3–4, 2021. The ordinary exceptions under the obligation prior to the dispensation remain. Feel free to take any questions you might have to your pastor.

I want to express my gratitude for your fidelity, flexibility and patience during the unprecedented restrictions that we have had to endure over the past many months.

The City of Bend declared a local State of Emergency in response to the excessive heat. Professional fireworks displays at Vince Genna Stadium (**July 3rd**) and Pilot Butte (**July 4th**) will be as scheduled. Use of any personal fireworks is a Class A Civil infraction, and carries a fine up to \$750. The City of Bend is asking the community's support in complying with the ban on all fireworks until July 9th.


