



From the
Pastor



Historic Church Renovation



presentation was made at all the Masses last weekend, June 20–21, to give an update on the renovation efforts on the Historic Church, which is celebrating its 100th Anniversary this year. My sincere thanks to Kevin Link who prepared the presentation—and that I am now including in my column this weekend.

After the debt on the 27th Street Church was paid off, I included the renovation of the Historic Church as part of my “Vision 2025.” I then formed a committee of experienced persons to lead the renovation and restoration efforts. Last year’s budget allocated \$50,000 toward the Historic Church renovation, and that went toward the replacement of failing sidewalks at the front of the church and the addition of a radiant-heat, snow-melt system under the sidewalks. This greatly improved the appearance and safety at the front of the church.

In that same spirit, the committee has turned its attention toward replacing the failing stone retaining wall near the public sidewalk on Lava Road at the front of the church. This project also includes minor stone repairs at other landscape walls on the property. The plans for this work have been submitted to the city for permits and historic district approvals. Work is expected to begin in July, and it would take a major portion of this year’s budget for the renovation, which is \$200,000. Sidewalks and parking stalls will be closed, but the church will remain open as it is currently.

The Historic Committee also met with a company that specializes in interior design, renovation, and restoration of historic Catholic churches—Daprato Rigali Studios—a fourth-generation family run business from Chicago. It was Daprato Rigali Studios that designed and fabricated the beautiful back altar piece that was installed in our Historic Church more than a hundred years ago. Check out some of the amazing works at dapratorigali.com. Two representatives from the Daprato Rigali Studios flew here to Bend to meet with the renovation committee three weeks ago. We look forward to receiving their design input over the months to come, as we have tasked them to provide multiple options that will help create a “master plan” for the renovation. The focus will be on interior design and restoration; for example, interior plaster, flooring, paint, statuary, and trim. Exterior work will run in concert with interior work, such as restoration of the stained-glass windows, brick, wood, stone walls, etc. The work of such a plan may take many years to fund and execute.

We are also planning to modernize the failing mechanical system by adding a more efficient one that will both heat and cool the Historic Church. However, it is still undetermined as to whether this work can be accomplished in this year’s budget. Besides, the church finances have fallen \$100,000 below budget in the first six months of this year. Hopefully, your help and support will enable us to recover in the next six months.

In summary, we want to remind everyone that there is a lot of work to be done at the Historic Church. The work will take into consideration the devotional and liturgical beauty of our church—honoring the architectural history—while maintaining the function and safety of its use. Because of its age, this is an effort that may last many years and will benefit greatly from your financial assistance. Please pray for the success of this endeavor!
