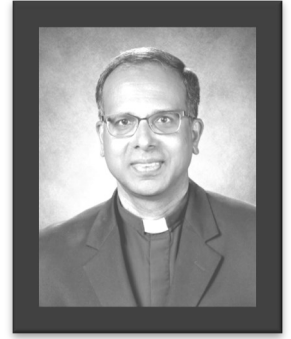

From the Pastor



Shrines of Italy Pilgrimage: Part 4

Early Wednesday morning at 6:30 a.m., we had a “box breakfast” and headed to the Basilica of St. Mary Major. We were at the basilica at a little after 7 a.m., and there was no crowd. Therefore, we were able to visit and pray at the tomb of Pope Francis without being rushed.

It is an amazing church—the first one built in Rome to honor Mary. It has the tombs of seven Popes, including Pope Francis. There is a picture of Mary that is believed to have been painted by St. Luke, and a piece of wood is from the manger of Jesus.

The Basilica Papale di Santa Maria Maggiore is the largest of the 80 Marian churches in Rome. This church was built in 432 by order of Pope Sixtus III on Esquiline Hill. It is one of the seven pilgrim churches and one of the four papal basilicas in Rome.

The Basilica of Santa Maria Maggiore was built on the site where the Virgin Mary appeared in a dream to Pope Liberius. This is also where a blanket of snow appeared on the hill on August 5th in the middle of summer. Many of the mosaics in the basilica are part of the original building. To the left of the main entrance is the Holy Door through which we walked through.

Due to the absence of a Papal audience this morning, I made arrangements for the pilgrims to visit the Pontifical North American College where the U.S. seminarians reside during their theological schooling. It is a beautiful building overlooking the dome St. Peter’s Basilica. I had spent a month there in Continuing Education, and Fr. Edward Linton, the director of Continuing Education, showed us around and took us to the viewing deck that gave us an amazing view of Rome. We thanked Fr. Ed and then walked over to St. Peter’s Square to have lunch and walk about at leisure.

Gian Lorenzo Bernini designed the square, including the massive Tuscan colonnades, four columns deep, which embrace visitors in the

“maternal arms of Mother Church.” On top of the colonnade consisting of 284 columns in four rows and a little over 52 feet high, stand 140 statues that are nearly 10 feet tall. Then some of us who had purchased tickets made our way to the dome.

After lunch, we went to the Basilica of St. John Lateran—the Cathedral Church of the Bishop of Rome—who is also the Pope. Built by Constantine the Great in the 4th Century AD, San Giovanni in Laterano is the first of the four major basilicas in Rome. John Lateran remains the cathedral church of Rome and the official ecclesiastical seat of the Pope as Bishop of Rome.

All five Lateran Councils met there, and it was the location of the signing of the Lateran Treaty. Indeed, it is the “mother church” of Roman Catholicism worldwide. Popes resided there for many centuries before moving to Vatican City in the 14th Century. This Cathedral Church has the relics of Peter and Paul, and right behind the main altar you find the “cathedra,” the chair from which Popes proclaim dogmas of faith—which are infallible—and all Catholics are bound to believe.

Next we went to the Santa Prassede Church to celebrate the Holy Mass. After the Mass, we went over to visit Santa Scala, the “Sanctuary of the Holy Stairs,” which is located just across from the Basilica of St. John Lateran. These stairs are believed to be from the palace of Pontius Pilot, the stairs that Jesus walked when He was brought before Pontius Pilot, which were brought to Rome by St. Helena, the mother of Constantine, the emperor, in the 4th Century. The faithful is allowed to ascend the stairs only on their knees. Some of us were brave enough to go up the stairs on our knees, while others walked up the adjacent stairs. It was a very spiritual experience to ascend the stairs on my knees, looking up at the crucifix on the top of those stairs, and saying a Hail Mary on each step. After the visit to the Holy Stairs, we returned to the hotel for dinner and to rest.

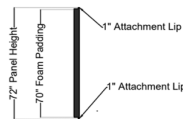

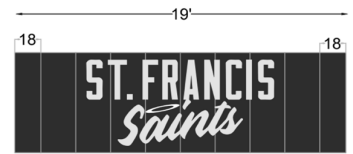
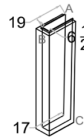
