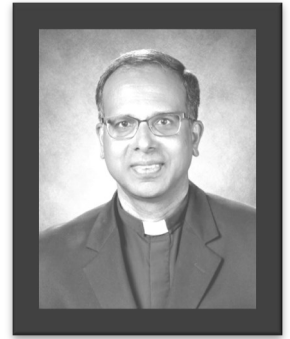

D From the Pastor



Shrines of Italy Pilgrimage: Part 2

Friday, May 9th, was a free day for all to spend in Assisi or go on an optional organized tour to Florence. The day began with 6am Mass in the beautiful chapel in the hotel. Twenty pilgrims had signed up to go on the organized tour and the rest of us spent mostly exploring Assisi.

Ten of us after breakfast took a taxi to the Church of San Damiano, the Church in which St. Francis prayed when Christ from the cross spoke to him, asking him to repair the Church that was in ruins. It was very special to be there. It is a very small church which can hold less than 50 people. It is an active church today with daily Masses. It was also here that St. Clare began her convent.

From there we took a taxi to San Rufino, the Cathedral Church of Assisi. Rufino was the first Bishop of Assisi who was martyred in the 4th Century. From there we walked over to the Basilica of St. Clare and then to the Basilica of St. Francis.

Walking around and getting lost is the best way to explore Assisi and create memorable experiences. We were able to go back to the hotel late that afternoon, relax and call it a day.

Then that evening there was the news that white smoke was detected and, therefore, we began a watch party for the new Pope with some wine and hors d'oeuvres. It was a shock and a delight when we learned that the new Pope was American. It is very historical to be there in Rome the morning of the day when the 267th successor of Peter was elected. Those who had gone to Florence had a great time and were back by 7 p.m. There is a lot to see in Florence, the cultural center of Italy. Those who went to Florence had a glimpse of a few things to see there.

Saturday, May 10th, after breakfast we checked out of the hotel and left for Loreto at 8:30 a.m. It was a beautiful drive, and we reached the Adriatic Coast where Loreto is located. In Loreto is the church that houses Mary's abode, where the Annunciation took place, and where the Word became Flesh in her womb. It is believed that her house was transported by the angels to protect it from invaders.

It is a large beautiful church with many side chapels, and the house of Mary is enclosed in a marble structure. We walked through the marble enclosure to see the house where a brick wall is exposed. The house is made up of bricks and wood found only in Nazareth where Mary lived.

We celebrated the Holy Mass in the chapel below the church and recited the Litany of Loreto. From there we made our way to Luciano, the place of the first Eucharistic miracle. We stopped on the way for lunch and got to Luciano by 4:30 p.m. We went into the church to see the bread

that had turned into the real flesh and the wine that turned into the real blood of Christ. It is still preserved, even after 1,200 years—which is in itself a miracle.

We came across several others making their visits, the majority of them children who are preparing for their first Holy Communion. We prayed and sang songs with them. It was very blessed to be there to see the Eucharistic miracle with our own eyes. We also went below the church to see the spot where the miracle occurred. After having spent about 40 minutes there, we made our way along the Adriatic Coast to San Giovanni Rotondo. We arrived at the hotel at 7:30 p.m., checked in, had dinner and then went to rest.

Sunday morning, May 11th, some of us went on an early morning walk up the hill behind the hotel. But we walked only for an hour as we didn't have a lot of time. The breakfast was served at 7:30, and we left the hotel at 8:30 a.m. to visit the Sanctuary of St. Michael the Archangel. It is a Roman Catholic shrine on Mount Gargano in the province of Foggia, in northern Apulia. It is the oldest shrine in Western Europe that is dedicated to the Archangel Michael, and it has been an important site of pilgrimage since the early Middle Ages.

The Archangel Michael is said to have appeared in 490, 492 and 1656. The most mysterious part of the Sanctuary is certainly the cave, where tradition has it that the Archangel Michael appeared. That cave of St. Michael is amazing! Somehow you feel a Holy Presence there in the cave, despite the significant number of tourists who are all crammed in at once.

Walking a couple miles from there we reached the Adriatic Sea Coast. After having our lunch there, we returned to the hotel for a little rest and then went over to the Shrine of Padre Pio. It is also an amazing place. We celebrated the Mass in the old convent—where Padre Pio celebrated Mass—and it was very special. There are several relics of Padre Pio on display. His incorruptible body is also there on display in the New Shrine. The New Shrine is so huge that it can seat about 7,000 people.

The hospital that he built is adjacent to the Basilica. And to the right of it are also the Stations of the Cross, which we were unable to visit due to lack of time, as there are several steps you have to climb to walk the stations.

After our visit to the Shrine of Padre Pio, some of us walked back to the hotel, while others took the shuttle bus.

After getting back to the hotel, we had a "pasta making session." Some of us tried our hand at making pasta—and it mostly went well. Then we had our dinner and then we retired to rest.
