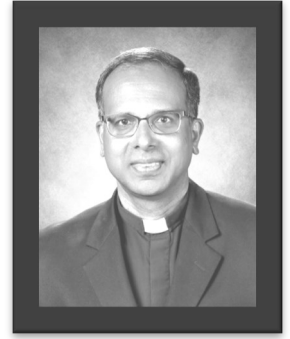

From the Pastor



Shrines of Italy Pilgrimage: Part 5

On Thursday, May 16th, we left the hotel at 8 a.m., after breakfast and made our way to St. Peter's Basilica. We began with the tour of the Vatican museums. It truly is enormous, with over 70,000 artworks within the walls of Vatican City. This museum contains masterpieces by painters such as Giotto, Leonardo, Michelangelo and Caravaggio. The modern religious art collection is of great value. It has art collections that date back to pre-Christian era. It is a lot of walking but worth every step.

The Vatican museum tour led us to the Sistine Chapel where the cardinals had gathered to elect the new Pope. I was glad the election was completed, and it was open to the public again. The Sistine Chapel is the large papal chapel built within the Vatican between 1477 and 1480 by Pope Sixtus IV, for whom the chapel is named. It is one incredible place with the amazing work of Michael Angelo and other well-known artists. The most important artworks in the chapel are the frescoes by Michelangelo on the ceiling and on the west wall behind the altar. Michelangelo painted the ceiling between 1508 and 1512, and then returned to paint "The Last Judgement" later. Along the center of the ceiling are nine scenes depicting the Story of Creation, the Downfall of Humanity, and the Story of Noah as told in the Book of Genesis. The wall paintings of Pietro Perugino, Botticelli, Ghirlandaio, and Rosselli feature stories from the Old Testament and from the life of Jesus. These wall paintings, along with Michelangelo's ceiling frescoes, make the Sistine Chapel a treasure trove of Renaissance art and a testament to the biblical narratives that inspired them.

We spent about 15 minutes in the chapel and then made our way to the lower level of the Basilica which has more than 100 tombs of Popes, most importantly, the tomb of St. Peter which is located right below the main altar. The tombs of Popes John Paul II and John XXIII have been moved to the main level of the Basilica after their canonization. From the lower level, we took the stairs to the main level of the Basilica. It is hard to describe in words the magnificence and the beauty of the largest Church in the world. In the center is the main altar at which only the Pope celebrates Mass. At the back is the altar of the chair over which is the iconic stained-glass window of the Holy Spirit. There are several side chapels, including a chapel of adoration.

We then had about an hour to use restrooms and find something to eat. At about 2 p.m., we regrouped to do our pilgrim walk to the holy door. We gathered at the beginning of the driveway leads to the Squire to begin the walk. Carrying the pilgrims' Cross, singing and reciting prayers, we made our way to the holy door. It was the unique experience of the Jubilee Year. There is a special lane only for the pilgrim walk. Through the holy door we made our way to the front of the main altar. That is the closest anyone can

get to the main altar. There, before the main altar we concluded the pilgrim walk with the final blessing. Then we had an hour to walk about the Basilica, explore and pray.

I spent the time visiting the altars of Sts. John Paul II, John XXIII, the Pieta, the adoration chapel, and the Chapel of Our Lady of Hope, spending a few minutes in prayer at each of those places. At about 3:45 p.m., we walked over to the Church of the Holy Spirit to celebrate the Holy Mass. After the Mass, we returned to the hotel for a few minutes, and then went over to a restaurant for the farewell dinner. It was a great setting with a four-course dinner, music and live singing.

Friday, May 16th, was our final day of pilgrimage—the extra day I had specially requested to visit the fourth major Basilica in Rome, the Basilica of St. Paul outside the Wall. After breakfast at the hotel, we set out at 8:15 a.m. to visit the Basilica. It was built in the 4th Century AD. It was commissioned by Emperor Constantine and constructed on the traditional site of St. Paul the Apostle's burial. The current basilica was rebuilt after a fire in 1823 and completed in 1854. It has the tomb of St. Paul, part of the chain that bound St. Paul in the prison, and pictures of all the Popes starting with St. Peter. It was very special to celebrate Mass in this magnificent Church in the Chapel of St. Benedict.

After our visit to the Church, we had the rest of the day at leisure to explore. Some of us decided to visit the Jewish Ghetto, others to explore more at St. Peter's, and the rest returned to the hotel. I had already purchased a ticket to go up to the dome, so after grabbing a sandwich to eat, I made my way to the Basilica, looking for the flight of stairs that took people to the top of the dome. The stairs are located inside the Basilica to the left of the main door, and there are 551 steps to reach the top of the dome. Visitors can optionally take the elevator to a lower level and then climb 320 steps to the top. The first section of the climb, using the elevator or stairs, takes you to a terrace with a view, a souvenir shop, and a restaurant. And then you need to climb the 320 steps to the very top. The views from the top are stunning, and I highly recommend it to all if you are healthy enough to climb those stairs. You get a view of the inside and outside of the Basilica from the dome which is massive and the views stunning. Make sure to get your tickets ahead of time.

After the dome visit, I spent a few minutes in prayer, did a little bit of shopping, and walked back to the hotel, gathering some "lost sheep" on the way.

The next day, the first group left for the airport at 5:45 a.m., while others left later in the day. It was a memorable trip where we grew in faith and friendship. Thanks to all who joined this pilgrimage and to all who prayed for us.

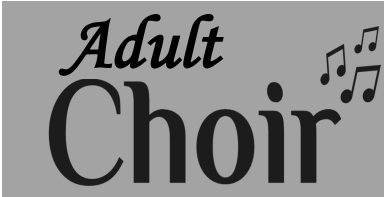
