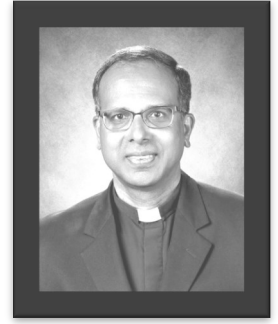

P From the Pastor

A Farewell Note with Deep Gratitude



Not having missed the Pastor's Page even for a single week in the last 9 years, I am happy to write the last one. I came to the United States in 2007. A week after I arrived, I was appointed Pastor at Holy Redeemer Church in La Pine with 3 Missions.

After being there for 5 years, I was unexpectedly transferred to Blessed Sacrament Church in Ontario. I barely completed 4 years there when I was asked to take up Bend due to the abrupt departure of Fr. Julian. I was not fully aware of all the implications of that move.

When I arrived at St. Francis in July of 2016, I found a church that was struggling to pay its monthly mortgage of \$28,000 on the loan it had taken to build the new church on 27th Street and generate enough tithing to pay for its daily operations. The church still had a \$3.1 million loan to pay. Besides, there were also several nervous parishioners who dreaded to see the Historic Church being sold to pay off the loan.

The St. Francis School went up to only the 6th grade, with a total of 98 students when I arrived. There were 4 full-time parish staff and 2 part-time. It was a parish that was just beginning to heal and come together after having gone through a very turbulent time a couple of years prior to my arrival.

I have been here now for 9 years—the longest I've ever been in any church. We have come a long way from where we have been 9 years ago. I spent several months listening and getting feedback from you and several hours in prayer to discern the direction to take. Then I presented a 10-year vision for St. Francis: first to the parish council; then to a mortgage elimination committee; then a select group of people and then to all. It consisted of a plan to pay off the mortgage in 5 years, recruiting nuns to teach in the school, building a rectory at the new church, opening another access to the new church, renovating and restoring the Historic Church, making the School financially stable, increasing the student enrollment to 200, complete several deferred maintenance works, building community, initiating faith development activities, and deepening the love for the Eucharist. Together we have achieved most of it. I am very grateful for your sacrifices and support to make this vision a reality. It has proved that when we make a little sacrifice and do our share, the Lord will put in His share, and what happens next is almost miraculous.

We have had several retreats, conferences, parish missions, bible studies, book studies, and prayer events to grow in faith. After the first retreat 8 years ago, we began the all-night adoration on every first Friday of the month which still continues, and I hope it continues even after I leave. The Eucharistic Adoration M–F and benediction at the end of all weekend Masses once a month have helped to deepen our love for the Lord in the Eucharistic. We have grown from 1,645 households to 2,250 households in 9 years.

We have had many community building events apart from providing coffee and doughnuts after the morning Masses on Sundays which has seen huge growth that has provided opportunities for fellowship. We paid off the entire debt in less than 3 years—earlier than we made plans for—and Divine Providence sent us the Salesian nuns to teach in the school much sooner than expected, and we built a convent for them.

We opened two new accesses to the 27th Street facility, upgraded the heating system, and replaced the office entrance with a heated sidewalk at a cost of about \$350,000. The new rectory was completed and blessed in 2022. We replaced the failing retaining wall at the Historic Church, replaced the sidewalk with a heated walkway, and completed its renovation and restoration a month ago at the cost of \$4 million. We have raised about \$8 million in the last 9 years without hurting the daily operations of the church. That is a testimony to your incredible generosity. I am very grateful for your trust in me, your sacrifices and your generosity.

Our operating reserve increased 5 times to \$760,000 from what we had 9 years ago. We have built up a capital improvement reserve of \$280,000 and a scholarship fund of \$300,000. And the school is in a much better place financially. It has built up a healthy operating reserve of \$700,000 and gave back \$300,000 to the Foundation. And thanks to some parents, the Catholic High School of Mater Dei will open this fall. I cannot thank you all enough for your incredible sacrifices and generosity. As the life, activities, and the ministries grew in the parish, we had to grow its staffing as well. The staffing has doubled to meet the demands of various ministries. Apart from the two priests, today we have 7 full-time staff and 4 part-time staff.

The only part of the vision that has not been achieved yet is getting the school student enrollment up to 200. Some unfortunate events have prevented us from achieving this. However, I am very happy with where the school is today. This school year 2024–25 has been the best in my 9 years. The school leadership and staffing are the best so far. The School Advisory Committee is very cohesive, hardworking, and deeply invested in the school. The enrollment has already exceeded expectations for next school year, and I am very hopeful that in the next two years, the enrollment will reach the goal.

Also, the FOCUS missionaries are doing a tremendous job. As we have re-visioned to focus on our mission to evangelize and make disciples, we got the help we needed from FOCUS. This first year the missionaries have established a solid foundation and strong connections. I am very excited about how the parish will blossom in evangelizing in the next couple of years with their help. I will be watching!

I know that I am not perfect; I know I'm sometimes grouchy, impatient, and appear unfriendly.

I deeply apologize for those moments. I am highly focused. Therefore, when I have set a goal, I go for it, and in that process some might feel slighted, ignored or uncared for. I am very sorry. Thanks for putting up with me despite all my weaknesses. I'm very grateful to each of you for your kindness and graciousness to me and your love and sacrifices for the church.

I have been on "overdrive" during my time here, and I'm looking forward to a slower pace and a bit of a break. We've grown closer to the Lord and to one another. You inspire me, and I am humbled by your deep sense of prayer and attachment to the Lord.

Please keep me and my new parish, St. Mary's Church in Pendleton, in your prayers. Don't hesitate to stop by if you are in the Pendleton area. The Roundup is in September, so get your tickets before they are sold out. I hope to see some of you then. Be assured of my prayers. Although sad, I feel very blessed to leave St. Francis better than I found it because of God's grace and your incredible sacrifices.
