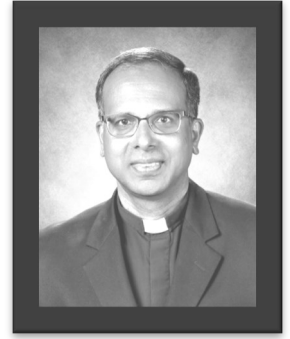

## From the Pastor



### *Shrines of Italy Pilgrimage: Part 3*

**O**n Monday, May 12th, after breakfast we checked out of our hotel in Giovanni Rotondo at 8 a.m., and we made our way to Salerno—to the Cathedral Church which houses the tomb of St. Matthew, the evangelist and apostle.

Salerno Cathedral (or *duomo*) is the main church in the city of Salerno in southern Italy and a major tourist attraction. The Cathedral was built when the city was the capital of the Principality of Salerno, over a more ancient church (“Church of Santa Maria degli Angeli and San Giovanni Battista”) from the last Roman centuries. Situated right in the middle of the historic center of the town, the Cathedral features a grand Romanesque entrance and a 12th Century bell tower.

The star attraction is the crypt. The elaborate baroque design is considered one of the cultural and architectural treasures of Southern Italy. The ceiling frescoes depict scenes from the Gospel of Matthew and some history of Salerno.

The right apse of the church above the crypt contains the tomb of Pope Gregory VII, considered one of the most important Popes of the Middle Ages, who died while in exile in Salerno in 1085. The beauty of the Church is something to behold. It was very special to celebrate the Holy Mass at the tomb of St. Matthew who was martyred in Ethiopia and whose body was moved to Salerno in the year 954.

After Mass we had a little over an hour to look around and have something to eat. After lunch we had the option of going back to the hotel to explore on our own or go on an organized tour to Pompeii. Those who returned to the hotel checked out the trails nearby and had a relaxing time. I chose to go on the organized tour to Pompeii.

The ancient Roman city of Pompeii is one of the most iconic archaeological sites in the world. Located near modern-day Naples, it was destroyed and buried under ash when Mount Vesuvius erupted in 79 AD, preserving its buildings and artifacts for future generations to explore. It is the only archaeological site in the world that provides a complete picture of an ancient Roman city. It is among the most popular tourist attractions in Italy, with approximately 2.5 million visitors annually.

There were a lot of people, but I loved walking about an ancient Roman city now unearthed and exposed to the world.

The ruins at Pompeii were first discovered late in the 16th Century by the architect Domenico Fontana. The systematic excavation began there in 1738.

After an informative and enlightening tour, we checked into the hotel for the evening. At dinner we raised a toast for the mothers in our group for Mother’s Day. We honored them with a prayer, presented them with a medal of Padre Pio and Blessed Mary, and gave a lovely rose flower to each. Everyone had a great time.

Tuesday, May 13th, a few of us got up early to go hiking. After a great morning hike, we had breakfast and checked out of the hotel at 8 a.m. to make our way to Rome.

On the way, we stopped at Monte Cassino, the place of St. Benedict and his twin sister, Scholastica. Monte Cassino Abbey, the first monastery of the Benedictine Order, is located at the top of Mount Cassino, a rocky hill just west of the town of Cassino. The Abbey was founded by Benedict of Nursia in 529 on a site that, according to a biography by St. Gregory the Great, was previously dedicated to the god Apollo.

It was ransacked by invaders and rebuilt many times until During World War II, when it was bombed in 1944 by the Allies, mistakenly believing it to be occupied by the German military. Reconstruction took more than a decade and it was rededicated by Pope Paul VI in 1964. Below the main altar are the tombs of St. Benedict and St. Scholastica.

From Monte Cassino we drove over to the Catacomb of San Callisto, taking a break on the way for lunch. The tour of the catacomb started at about 4 p.m. and lasted about 45 minutes.

There are more than 60 catacombs, which are underground burial sites, in and around Rome. Only five of these are currently open to the public. Catacombs are the official underground cemetery of the Church of Rome in the 3rd Century AD. Around half a million Christians were buried here, among them many martyrs and 16 popes. The catacomb we visited is named after the deacon St. Callixtus who, at the beginning of the 3rd Century AD, was assigned by Pope Zephyrinus to the administration of the cemetery.

After the tour of the catacomb, we celebrated Mass in the chapel built over the catacomb. We then returned to the hotel in Rome.
