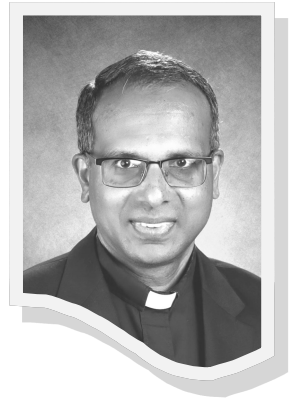

## From the Pastor



### Splendid India Tour 4

After lunch at my oldest brother's house, we walked over to my uncle's house, and then back to my family home, where my brother demonstrated how to peel a coconut that he'd picked from a tree in the backyard.

I explained the three "eyes" of the coconut and how the main eye can easily be opened to empty the water. Then I cut it open to expose its "meat." We use every part of the coconut tree—nothing goes to waste. We have a lot of coconut trees in the state—in fact, the name Kerala means "the land of the coconut." My brother then pulled up a tapioca plant to show its roots—which is called *kappa* or tapioca.

Next, we walked over the backyard of my family home to see turmeric, ginger, black pepper, nutmeg, cashew, coffee, jackfruit and mango trees. Then we tasted various jackfruit and tapioca preparations, such as *vattayappam*, *achappam*, *kozhallappam*, *halva*, and banana chips.

After that, we visited another uncle's house, the elementary school that I attended, and the parish church where I was baptized, received 1st Communion, Confirmation, and my Priestly Ordination. However, the old church where I received all these sacraments was demolished, and a beautiful new church was built in its place three years ago.

From there, we made our way to the Vettikattu Plaza Hotel for dinner where my brother works and which was only a mile away. The guests were served drinks as we waited for the rest of my family to join us.

Then all the guests were ceremoniously and traditionally welcomed by sprinkling them with *panineer* (scented water), applying sandalwood paste on the forehead, and putting a *punnada* (a special piece of garment) on each one.

After we were seated and dinner was served, the girls' dance team from the local school—including my cousins' children—performed three

dances to the delight of all the guests. One was a "prayer dance," and another was a "hip hop."

The third dance was the *Margamkali*—a ritual folk-art dance from the Syrian Christians of the Kottayam and Thrissur districts, in which a dozen dancers sing and dance around a lighted-wick lamp, and wearing the traditional white *dhoti* and sporting a peacock feather on their turbans to add a touch of color. This is an allegorical enactment—with the lamp representing Christ—and the performers His Disciples. The performance is usually held in two parts and begins with songs and dances narrating the life of St. Thomas, the Apostle. These songs date back to a period much before the Portuguese invasion.

After the dances, I introduced all of my extended family to the guests. And then as we were having dinner, three singers from the church entertained us. The guests couldn't resist the temptation of getting up to dance to the tunes—and soon most of us were dancing.

Everyone thoroughly enjoyed the evening, and before the guests had left, they were each given a *Nilavilakku* as a gift from my family. This is an oil lamp that is very special to the State of Kerala.

We welcome any family member's guests as part of the family with open arms, and I'm very appreciative of the way my extended family made everyone in the tour group to feel as if they were a part of it. And, thus, after a very special day with my family, we drove back to the hotel to rest.

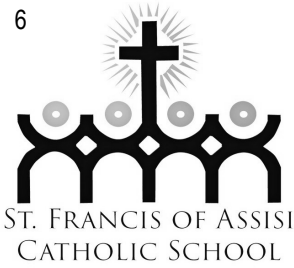
