



From the Pastor



Historic Church Restoration and Renovation

I would like to give you an update on the progress of the Historic Church restoration and renovation plan. After the debt on the 27th St. Church was paid off, I included the renovation of the Historic Church as part of my Vision 2025. I then formed a committee of people with a variety of skillsets to lead the restoration and renovation efforts. They met a number of times and made priority recommendations.

As a part of that, in 2019 we replaced the failing sidewalks at the front of the church with the addition of a radiant-heat, snow-melt system under the sidewalks. This has greatly improved the appearance and safety in front of the church, and it has proved to be a great blessing, especially over the past two winters.

In that same spirit, the committee turned its attention toward replacing the failing stone retaining wall near the public sidewalk on Lava Road at the front of the church in 2020. This project also included minor stone repair at other landscape walls on the property. The plans for this work were approved by the City and the Historic District Landmark Commission after a rigorous review. Work began on the retaining wall late in the summer, and most of it was completed before the end of the year.

The Historic Church Restoration and Renovation Committee (HCRRC) also met with a company that specializes in interior design, renovation and restoration of historic Catholic churches. Daprato Rigali Studios is a fourth-generation, family-run business from Chicago. It was the Daprato Rigali Studios that designed and fabricated the beautiful back altar piece and installed it in our Historic Church more than a hundred years ago. Check out some of their amazing works at dapratorigali.com. Two representatives from Daparto met with us at the Historic Church twice in-person and three times over ZOOM. They have come up with a stunning design that includes the total restoration and renovation of the church to the great satisfaction of the

HCRRC. The beautiful design is displayed at both churches. The restoration and renovation include everything, such as interior plaster, flooring, painting, statuaries, communion rails, new altar and ambo that match with the rest of the sanctuary design, refinishing the pews, modernizing the failing mechanical system, adding a more efficient system that will both heat and cool the Historic Church, restoration of the stained-glass windows, brick, wood, stone walls, etc. However, all these come with a cost.

Therefore, the HCRRC needs your input on how to proceed. Please read the brochure, and take the survey on the Parish Website at: stfrancisbend.org to give your input. Paper surveys are available at both churches if you do not have access to a computer. Do not respond to the survey thinking of the present COVID situation we are in. Instead, think ahead to the next 3 to 5 years when you take the survey. The total project will cost about \$2.5M. The work does not need to be done all at one time or in a year. It is possible to space it out for 3 to 5 years.

In summary, we want to remind everyone to share your thoughts and help us to chart a path forward by taking the survey. There is a lot of work to be done on the Historic Church. This work will consider the devotional and liturgical beauty of our church—honoring the architectural history—while maintaining function and safety of its use. The Historic Church is a beacon of hope and the visible landmark of the presence of the Catholic faith in Bend. It has been 100 years since that church was built, and we want to make sure that it remains an attractive landmark that witnesses to the beauty of our Catholic faith for another 100 years, bringing people to Christ, offering them hope and eternal salvation. Please take the survey, and let us know what you think so that the HCRRC can determine a path forward. I thank you for your help.



St. Francis Preschool and Pre-K

Faith Formation

Confirmation 2021: Students preparing to receive Confirmation in 2021 should be (1) Giving at least 10 hours of service to the community—neighbors, church, (2) Researching a saint and writing a short paragraph, (3) Meeting with their sponsors either in person or virtual to complete the 4 workshops, (4) Getting familiar with the seven Gifts of the Holy Spirit and twelve Fruits of the Holy Spirit, and (5) writing a letter to Bishop Cary explaining how you carried out and grew in faith from the last four points.

RCIA and Sacrament Preparation for Adults (age 18 and older): This is the class for Baptized Catholic adults who never received 1st Communion and/or Confirmation, and for unbaptized adults or baptized non-Catholic adults wishing to be received into the Catholic Faith. We do weekly homework and then come together every Thursday night on ZOOM.
