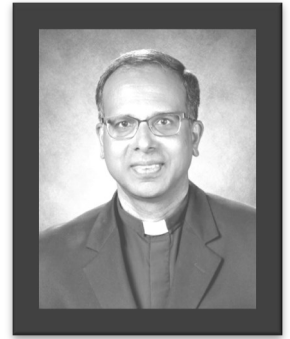

From the Pastor



Shrines of Italy Pilgrimage: Part 1

I would like to reflect on our recently concluded pilgrimage to the Shrines of Italy. After over a year of planning and preparation, this special pilgrimage during this jubilee year began on May 6th. Prior to the start, we had three sessions led by Dcn. Steve and Mary McGlone to familiarize ourselves with the places on the tour itinerary—one session to get to know those on the pilgrimage—and another session by a Collette rep to be ready for the trip.

We were 36 of us making this journey, and it took several routes and different airlines to get to Rome. The single largest group took the Seattle–Amsterdam route, touching down at Rome Airport at about 5 p.m. on Wednesday, May 7th. The last group arrived at the hotel by midnight the same day. We had a welcome group dinner at 7:30 p.m.—the four-course dinner was delicious.

It was a historic day to be in Rome as the Conclave to elect the new Pope had just begun a few hours before our arrival. The only voting on the first day of the Conclave ended with the black smoke, indicating that no one candidate had received two-thirds of the votes needed to be elected Pope.

On the morning of May 8th, the first full day after the arrival in Rome, I invited those interested in our party to join me to do something that was not on our itinerary: a walk to St. Peter's Square before we left at 8 a.m. for Assisi. There were several brave souls who walked with me over to the Square at 5:30 in the morning—a brisk, 30-minutes' walk from the hotel.

The place was totally empty except for a few media persons. We took some amazing pictures, and we saw the chimney that was the focus of the entire world, and the window where the new Pope would be introduced to the world.

At that time, we had no clue that the new Pope would be elected that same evening and introduced from the very window we were looking at. It was very special to be there on the morning of May 8th, when in the evening of that same day, the 267th successor of St. Peter was elected—the first American Pope. We returned to our hotel at about 7 a.m., had breakfast, and left for Assisi at 8 a.m.

Assisi is the city of saints—St. Francis of Assisi, St. Chiara of Assisi, and St. Carlo Acutis—and its peaceful spirit is palpable with every step through its beautiful streets. It is the jewel of Umbria, in the province of Perugia, perched on the slopes of Mt. Subasio.

The drive to Assisi from Rome took a little over three hours, with a 15-minute break in between. Upon arriving at Assisi, we went directly to visit St. Mary of the Angels Basilica. This is a huge church that houses the Portiuncula (the little portion). Initially, it was a small chapel dedicated to Our Lady of St. Mary of the Angels. It was rebuilt by St. Francis after his vision before the Crucifix in San Damiano.

Benedictine monks gifted the property to St. Francis in 1211. The Portiuncula became St. Francis' headquarters and later a significant pilgrimage site after his death in 1226.

In the 16th Century, a vast Basilica—the Basilica of St. Mary of the Angels—was built around it. This Basilica also houses the spot where St. Francis died and the cell where he lived. To the right of the Church are rose bushes without thorns that grow only there. It is said that those roses lost thorns because St. Francis used to throw himself over them when he had doubts and temptations.

After visiting this Basilica, we made our way to the Basilica of St. Clare. After having lunch, we toured this Basilica that contains the tomb of St. Clare and houses several relics such as the cross that spoke to St. Francis, hair of St. Clare, her tunic and several other items.

From there we walked over to St. Mary Major which houses the body/tomb of Carlo Acutis. Assisi is visited by a lot of young people—mostly teenagers—because of Carlo Acutis (May 3, 1991–October 12, 2006) Carlo was a British-born teenager, primarily of Italian ancestry, and known for his devotion to the Eucharist which became a core theme of his life prior to his death from leukemia at the age of 15 in 2006. He was beatified in 2020 and was scheduled to be canonized on April 27th. This has been suspended, however, due the passing of Pope Francis. Carlo will be the first millennial to be canonized.

Next, we made our way to the Basilica of St. Francis. This Basilica has three levels. The Basilica of St. Francis of Assisi is the mother church of the Roman Catholic Order of Friars Minor Conventual in Assisi—a town in the Umbria region in central Italy—where St. Francis was born and died. Composed of two churches, the Lower and the Upper, its crypt houses Francis' tomb. It is a papal minor basilica and one of the most important places of Christian pilgrimage in Italy. With its accompanying friary, Sacro Convento, the basilica is a distinctive landmark to those approaching Assisi.

It was a blessing to be able to celebrate Mass here, recalling the life and mission of St. Francis. After the Mass, we made our way to the hotel which was only 10 minutes away. After we checked in, we heard the news that white smoke was detected at the Chimney over the Sistine chapel. So we began the dinner watch party to see the new Pope. Everyone was excited. We had just been there this morning and by evening we had a Pope. No one could believe that he was an American. Everyone was shocked but delighted that we have a Pope from the United States. With that excitement, the Central Oregon Daily News did a Facetime with us for this latest news report over Zoom. After a busy, long and exciting day, we retired to rest.

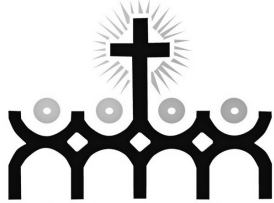
