

From the Pastor



Month of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus: Part 1

“Behold this Heart which has so loved men that It spared nothing, even going so far as to exhaust and consume Itself, to prove to them Its love.”

—Jesus to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque

The month of June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, a devotion which began in the 12th Century and gained popularity after Jesus appeared to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in the 1670s, revealing to her the image of His Sacred Heart. It is a month dedicated, therefore, to contemplating the wonderful mystery of the human heart of Jesus that contains all of God’s eternal, infinite, self-giving love for each person. In this month, the Church invites us to contemplate the Sacred Heart of Jesus and let ourselves be convinced of God’s passionate love for us.

In Jesus’ first apparition to St. Margaret Mary, after revealing His Heart to her, He said to her, “My divine Heart is so passionately fond of the human race, and of you in particular, that it cannot keep back the pent-up flames of its burning charity any longer. They must burst out through you.” Jesus appeared to Sr. Margaret Mary Alacoque with His heart visible outside His chest, on fire, and surrounded by a crown of thorns.

Flames: The Sacred Heart of Jesus burns with divine love. It is the fire of love—the fire that He longs to set is the fire of divine love, the fire of the Holy Spirit. One prayer to the Sacred Heart of Jesus says, “Oh Heart of Jesus, burning with love for us, inflame our hearts with love for You.” The Sacred Heart of Jesus is aflame with love for you and for me, and in the month of June, He wants to set our hearts on fire with His love, to consume all that is not His love, and to spread that love to those around us.

Rays of Light: The Sacred Heart of Jesus is surrounded by rays of light. Jesus is the light of the world as He mentions in the Gospel of John. The light shines in and dissipates the darkness, and it reveals the truth. The Sacred Heart of Jesus reveals to

us the eternal truth of God’s love for us, bringing the light of God’s love into the darkness of our sin and suffering, our fear and doubt.

Crown of Thorns: After He was condemned to be crucified, the soldiers placed a crown of thorns on Jesus’ head to ridicule Him. In one of His revelations to St. Margaret Mary, Jesus told her that the crown of thorns symbolizes our individual sins, which prick His heart.

The Cross: Jesus died on the cross. A cross was planted in the heart of Jesus at the moment of His incarnation. It was the Divine Love of the Sacred Heart that willingly accepted death on the Cross for our sake, and it is that same Divine Love that transforms the Cross into the most powerful act of redemption. It is the Cross of Christ that gives us the strength we need in our trials and sufferings.

The Open Wound: After Jesus dies on the cross, a soldier pierces His Heart with a lance, and blood and water flow out—the mercy of God floods the world. The open wound in the image of the Sacred Heart shows us that the Heart of Jesus is always open to us, His mercy is always available to us, that He never closes His Heart to us.

When for the secular society June is “pride” month, for the Catholic world it is the month of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. Devotion to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus is the antidote to the evils the society is facing today. In the month of June, I invite you specially to start each day praying the consecration to the Sacred Heart of Jesus:

*Divine Heart of Jesus,
through the Immaculate Heart of Mary,
I offer myself to God the Father in the Holy
Sacrifice of the Altar, with all of my works, studies,
prayers, sufferings and joys of today, in reparation
for our sins and so that your Kingdom may come.*
