



From the **P**astor



Moving ahead with Vision 2025

It has been over a year since the outbreak of COVID-19. Many adjustments have been made to the way we conduct ourselves in church to keep everyone safe. There are still many who have not returned to the in-person celebration of the Eucharist. I am very grateful for those of you who join us in person for the celebration of the Holy Eucharist and those of you who join us over the livestream. Your prayers and support keep us going. I pray daily for your safety and protection. We are very grateful to God that our school has been providing in-person classes right from the beginning, and we have not had an outbreak so far.

Although we are not fully back to our normal church life and activities, I do not want you to lose sight of the vision I had laid out for our parish a couple of years ago. Part of my Vision 2025 was having a rectory built on the site where the main church is located. Because the priests spend most of their day at the office at 27th Street, it would make it easier if the rectory were on the site. I have been praying about it, asking the guidance of the Holy Spirit. I promised the Holy Spirit that I would stay a few more years at St. Francis if he granted two of my intentions, and the great news is that both requests have been granted—one of which was a clear path forward in building the new rectory. You are stuck with me :) for a little more time. I am amazed at how God has put everything in just the right places.

Two years ago when I had talked to someone about my vision of having a rectory built at 27th Street, he expressed his interest in supporting the efforts. However, I did not know what that support meant. Then came COVID-19 and everything was on hold. However, he had not forgotten it. A year later, he called to ask me where I was with my plan on building the new rectory. I then realized that God wanted me to move ahead with it, so I started thinking about it seriously. I contacted the representative of Simplicity Homes (of Hayden Homes) who built the convent to see if he would be interested in taking on this project. He let me know that he was very interested in it, and so John Schimmoller and I met with the planning and design team. We came up with

a plan that is identical to the convent with only some interior modifications.

The exciting news is that Hayden Homes has offered to build it at a discounted price, and a generous donor has contributed toward it, with a little help from another generous parishioner. The plans have been approved by the Parish and Finance Councils as well as the Bishop. Although two very generous donors will pay for the cost of building the new rectory, there are other things—such as the landscaping, fencing, window blinds, and furnishings that I will need help with. I trust in God’s amazing generosity, and I am sure we will have more than what we need.

The new rectory will be 3159 sq. ft., with two suites and two guest rooms. It will be built on the far end of the field, and the space between the school and the field will serve as the driveway to the rectory as you come up the main driveway. The new rectory plan has been submitted to the City of Bend and, as soon as it is approved, we will come together to pray and have the ground-breaking.

Nearly two years ago, the City had approved our application to have two more accesses to our 27th Street facility. We opened one access at the back of the parking lot and waited to see how it worked before working on the second access. We have now applied to the City for the permit to open the second access, and we hope to complete it this year. This will connect the parking lot to the Tucson Way cul-de-sac in front of the convent.

Apart from these plans, we are also looking at ways to evangelize and make disciples for Christ, which was a big part of my Vision 2025. You will hear more about this exciting effort in the coming weeks and months. We may be in a pandemic, but we cannot forget Christ’s command to make disciples for him: “Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit” (Mt 28:19). Please keep all this in your prayers as we move ahead discerning and fulfilling God’s plans for our community.
