

From the Pastor



Historic Church: Survey 1

A few weeks ago we did an online survey requesting your input on how to proceed with the restoration and renovation of the Historic Church.

The Historic Church Renovation and Restoration Committee (HCRRC) proposed three levels of renovation, and you were asked to choose the one that you would prefer. Details of each level of renovation with their costs were made available online, and you were asked to read those details before choosing the level.

I am very grateful to the 220 of you who responded to the survey. Of those of you who responded, 50 (22.7%) chose Level 1, 79 (36%) chose Level 2, and 91 (41.3%) chose Level 3.

Most of you wrote in your comments with your choice. I am very appreciative of that. Your comments are very insightful in choosing a direction to proceed, and they were very positive and encouraging. The HCRRC then came together to discuss the results of the survey, proposed to make them available to all parishioners, and allow enough time to “digest” the results.

Starting last weekend, we have published the survey results in the parish bulletin. We also have a display in the main church narthex that shows the survey results and comments, but we have not included anyone’s name or any comment that might point toward anyone’s name. Please take time to go over them in the narthex.

In the coming weeks, I hope to address some of the questions you’ve asked in the comment section. All of you agree that we need to maintain the Historic Church, which is a symbol of a strong Catholic presence in Bend. Here are a few comments:

“The church is an icon for our parish and our faith in the community . . .”

“The church is an important piece of Bend’s history and needs to be treated as such. It needs to be usable space.”

“Authentic worship requires beauty, and Catholicism is strong in Bend.”

“The Historic Church has stood for 100 years, and this (renovation) would prepare the church for the next 100 years—and possibly beyond.”

“It stands as a beacon of faith, not only for Catholics, but for the whole community to see. It is constructed to properly show devotion to God and deserves to be preserved so as to reflect God’s beauty and rightly order us to true worship.”

Many of you who chose Level 1 are concerned about the current situation in which we are living and its financial implications for the parish. Here are a few specific comments:

“I feel we are facing the pressures of a pandemic, and taking on a project as large as the entire restoration isn’t appropriate at this time.”

“With the economic situation as it is, it is not a wise idea to take on a new million-dollar-plus debt.”

“At this time, given the pandemic we are experiencing, I believe the Level 1 plan is best.”

“With many parishioners in financial turmoil right now and, since we have not even been able to meet our weekly offering needs, I think we should commit one level at a time.”

Whatever may be the level we decide to do, I would like us to have 75 percent of the cost in hand before we commence doing the work. We are all hoping that we will move out of our current COVID situation, and get back to a normal sort of life and activities.




LaPine SVdP Donation Truck




8th Grader, **Lindsey Maloney** is directing a play taken from "Scripture Superheroes." The after school Drama Club will perform for the students on **June 15th**.
