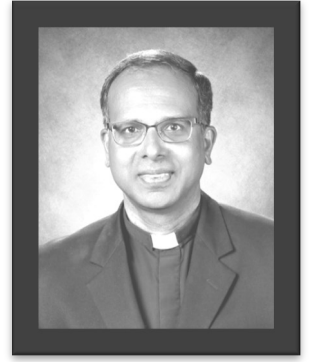

## From the Pastor



# *Giving Thanks to God: Blessing and Reopening of the Historic Church*

**W**e are coming to the end of the renovation of the 105-year-old Historic Church. Except for tying up a few loose ends, we have completed most of the renovation and restoration. Daprato Rigali Studios have done an amazing job with the stained-glass windows and the interior renovation.

The Stations of the Cross look stunning, and the pews have been refinished with precision and grandeur. The center aisle tiling with the three logos of the Eucharist, Tau Cross and Baptism draw you to the sanctuary, reminding you of what we celebrate there.

The outer aisle carpet matches with the burgundy in the lower windows of the stained glass windows and the kneelers. Skim coating and painting of the sidewalls, and repairing, cleaning and painting the ceiling have tied everything together with the sanctuary, which was completed under Phase 1 of the renovation. The entire layout looks amazing.

The stained-glass window frames received new painting making them stand out very beautifully. The two-inch frame around the stained-glass windows received a different color, making them stand out and very special.

You cannot miss the rose window when you are in the church. The new paint job on the frames of the window has made a huge difference. I can't believe the difference simple changes have made. These are clearly master touches. That is why they are paid the big bucks. We have so far raised \$930,000 toward a total expense of \$1.3 million of this final phase of the renovation. We have borrowed the rest from the Diocese to complete the work. After tying up all the loose ends, we will have spent almost \$4 million toward the renovation and restoration of the Historic Church. It speaks volumes of our parish that we have raised 90% of it already. It is money well spent. Each of you can be proud of your sacrifices to leave a legacy of Catholic faith for generations to come.

I am very appreciative of all your sacrifices. We have done, with God's grace and your generosity, what was seemingly impossible. I am very grateful to

the Bishop who has always supported our efforts and encouraged us with his presence, suggestions and keen interest. I thank the priests who joined us for the first blessing and who will join us for the final blessing and reopening.

We are very grateful to Daprato Rigali Studios who have done a magnificent job, Sun West Builders who did most of the exterior work, Bend Electric for all the electrical work, Pinnacle Architecture for all the architecture support, Bend Audio Visual for the installation of the new sound system, the Bend City, Bend Historic Society, St. Francis Knights of Columbus for their sacrificing work, the Historic Church Renovation Committee for their patient work throughout the entire process, Tri County Paving, the Finance Council, the Parish Council, Dcn. Steve, Dcn. Phil, and all who have helped us through the entire process of renovation and restoration of the Historic Church.

We have been working hard making sacrifices for the renovation of the Historic Church for the past four years, planning, fundraising, and finally implementing. The Renovation is part of the 10-year vision for St. Francis that I had presented to you more than eight years ago. We have realized everything I set forth in my vision, such as paying off the \$3.1 million debt, building a convent, inviting nuns to teach in the school, building the new rectory, making the school financially stable, opening two additional entrances/exits to the 27th Street facility, completing many deferred maintenances, and finally completing the renovation and restoration of the Historic Church.

None of these would have happened without your sacrifices. Words cannot thank you enough for your generosity, your love for St. Francis, your love for your faith, your confidence in me, and above all your trust in God. May 5, 2025, will go down in the history of St. Francis as an important day of thanksgiving to God for what He has done in us as we complete another milestone and reopen the Historic Church.

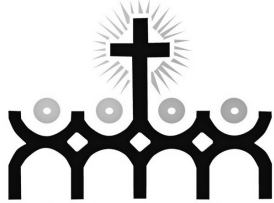
