

# From the Pastor



## My Dream Parish—Part II

*Empowered by the Holy Spirit, St. Francis of Assisi Catholic Church aspires to be a vibrant and welcoming community of disciples committed to worship, grow and serve. We invite all to a personal encounter with Jesus Christ, accompany them on their journey, and send them forth to be His witnesses.*

Continuing painting the picture of an amazing future of our parish solidly founded on our newly drafted vision statement stated above, I'd love to see vibrant youth ministries and summer camps in the parish, where young people have a safe place to hang out and engage in fun activities and grow in faith. I hope to see a parish where all its members, not just 20%, support the church financially according to what God has blessed them with. I'd love to see St. Francis become a cradle of vocations to priesthood and religious life and recognize, appreciate, and promote the sacredness of human life from the moment of conception until natural death. I would love to see many more of us spend time adoring Christ in the Eucharist and coming together as families to pray the rosary, divine mercy chaplet, liturgy of the hours, novenas and other private devotions and make our homes a place of love and prayer consecrated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary.

I look forward to a St. Francis where children can be in a self-supported parish school from Pre-K to 12th (High School), where parents do not have to worry about finding another school. I envision a school where each grade has at least 25 students. I look forward to a parish and school where entire families are brought into authentic encounters with Jesus and are engaged with their time and talents in activities of the Church so that no future parents and grandparents have to lament their children walking away from faith. I'd love to see a parish where the relevance of faith and how it impacts their families and relationships is obvious to everyone, where everyone is empowered to boldly talk about faith, and how Jesus has touched their lives. I'd love to see a parish that reaches out to the Bend community and is much involved in reaching out to the poor and needy. I look forward to a parish community of disciples, where

each one is committed to regular worship, to grow, and to serve.

Finally, I dream of a parish that is healthy and lively and growing—not because we have vibrant liturgies and preaching or interesting youth programs or social justice initiatives—but, rather, these are outcomes of a community that is healthy and growing because people are brought to Christ. This is a dream that is being realized, and with your support we can make this a complete reality. I would love to know what your dream parish would look like. If there is something in your dream parish that is not mentioned, here please let me know, and I will be happy to include that.

Jesus asked surprisingly to the one leper who returned to give thanks to him, “Ten were cleansed, were they not? Where are the other nine? Has none but this foreigner returned to give thanks to God?” Let us not be like the nine who never returned to thank the Lord. Let us be grateful to God for His blessing by giving to Him in return. The stewardship campaign, **Belong, Believe, Be Disciples**, is the opportunity to show your gratitude and to fulfill a dream. Let us respond with faith. I'd love to hear back from all 1,910 households that were mailed the campaign packets.
