



From the Pastor



Part 4: Stewardship 2021— *Walking by Faith* (2 Corinthians 5:7)

All of us at St. Francis can take great pride in what we have accomplished over a short time—paid off the debt, built a convent, strengthened the school, opened another access to the 27th Street Church, and tackled some of the much-needed deferred maintenance issues at both locations, such as the replacement of the walkway and the failing retaining wall at the Historic Church, upgrading the heating system and repaving the driveway at the 27th Street facility, and repaving the parking lot at the Historic Church. Thank you for supporting these efforts.

It might be easy now to sit back in fear due to COVID-19. Instead, like St. Paul, we must keep *walking by faith*. And, what is the goal? For me, it is a parish full of people who have chosen to be intentional Disciples of our Lord, Jesus Christ, and of his Church—parishioners who are enthusiastic about sharing the Good News, about inviting others to join us, and about building the Kingdom here in Bend. This has been my vision from the beginning. And, while it will not be realized overnight, we must continue to progress toward its fulfillment. Here are priorities that I see for this upcoming year 2021:

First, we must strengthen our **Offertory Collection**. We are a growing community with challenging needs. Bend is the second fastest-growing city in the country. Two churches, a school and many ministries make the Offertory Collection our highest priority. We need to recover from our Offertory losses due to COVID-19. The expenses do not go down because some do not come to church. Only a few parishes in the diocese have experienced a reduction in Offertory due to COVID-19. Most parishes have maintained their Offertory, and some of them have seen an increase in it—mostly because of their regular givers increasing their Offertory without even being asked.

We have been in touch with all of you using live stream, the Parish App and Parish Website. We have checked on the welfare of our parishioners using email, phone calls and regular mail ever since the “COVID shut down.” If you have not been part of our email, phone call or regular mail, you will need to register with the parish or call the Office to update your information.

The second priority is the **Historic Church**. Blessed and consecrated in 1920, it is a landmark, testifying to the sacrifices and generosity of the 13-family Catholic community of that time. More than just a building, it is the beacon of Catholic faith in Bend. Today, after 100 years, it needs renovation so that it can continue to draw people in, to offer hope, and to feed the body and soul of generations to come. We are finalizing the renovation plan for the Historic Church. Stop by the narthex to see the exciting interior renovation design. We will have a detailed presentation of the plan soon.

Finally, we need to make our **Parish School** affordable for all our parish families through the Parish Scholarship Fund. Thanks to your support, we are able to give financial aid to 42 students this year to attend St. Francis School for a total of \$80,000. We need to continue to build up this fund.

The year 2021 will also be a year when we will launch new programs to help us become a better community of intentional disciples driven by our mission to proclaim the Gospel. I ask you to support this year’s Stewardship Drive, *Walking by Faith!* Together, we will create a community of vibrant intentional disciples focused on bringing Christ to a hurting world.

Won’t you join me? This is “First Fruits Commitment Weekend.” Please return your commitment card. You may drop it off in the Offertory or mail it in. We have extra pledge cards that will be handed out on the baptismal font and in the narthex of the church if you have forgotten or have not received one. Thanks for your commitment to becoming better stewards of God’s blessings.




