

# From the Pastor



## My Dream Parish—Part I

*Empowered by the Holy Spirit, St. Francis of Assisi Catholic Church aspires to be a vibrant and welcoming community of disciples committed to worship, grow and serve. We invite all to a personal encounter with Jesus Christ, accompany them on their journey, and send them forth to be His witnesses.*

The above is the exciting new Vision for our parish. I would like to paint the picture of the parish when this vision is fully realized. It is the picture of a dream parish. Though this dream is being realized, it may take several years to realize it completely. I am painting the picture of a future that we look forward to with excitement. I look forward to a St. Francis Parish that everybody in the neighborhood—and in the diocese—talks about. Not because it looks like a spaceship, but because it is a place where everyone—sinners and saints—finds a beacon of hope and a light to the community. It is where people in Bend and in its outlying areas can encounter Christ together and in one another. I dream of a parish where people feel safe enough to share their struggles with one another and loved enough to discern in what way God is calling them to use their gifts and find the support they need.

I'd love to see a Sunday Mass where people are proud to invite their friends. I look forward to a parish that has a culture of invitation where parishioners are neither afraid nor ashamed to invite others to church. I imagine a day when parishioners have family or friends visiting from out of town and will say, "We can hit the skiing slopes or go to the lake to fish later, but first let's go to Holy Mass at St. Francis."

I dream of a Sunday morning when people have the same sense of anticipation and excitement approaching the church as they do when going to dinner with friends. I would love to see everyone greeted at the door by familiar faces as they walk in, where people are excited to come in to meet their friends, and to joyfully praise and worship Christ in the Eucharist.

I'd love to see a welcome kiosk as people come in. I'd love to see coffee and refreshments after every Mass, giving the parishioners an op-

portunity to stay after Mass and enjoy fellowship and get to know their church family. I want to see St. Francis as a beehive of activities with various ministries, so that we need more space for meetings, Bible studies, faith-building activities for kids, teens, youth, young adults, singles, engaged couples, married couples, and social gatherings. I would like to see a gathering space where we can have 500 people sitting down for a wedding reception, funeral reception, or another celebration.

I wish to see a liturgy where the readers make the word of God come alive, where the homilies are inspiring and engaging, where the music is uplifting and transcendent. I'd love to have video screens that help the participants engage all their senses without burying their noses in the mis-salettes. I hope for a Sunday Mass that has joyful people singing, praying, and worshipping God in the Holy Eucharist where Christ is fully present body and blood, soul, and divinity.


