



# From the Pastor



## Stewardship 2022: *Rebuild My Church—Part II*

All of us at St. Francis can take great pride in what we have accomplished over the last five years. We paid off the \$3.1 million debt, built a convent, welcomed the Salesian Sisters to teach in our school, strengthened the school financially, setup a scholarship fund, opened another access to the 27th Street Church, tackled some of the much-needed deferred maintenance issues at both locations—such as replacing the walkway and repairing the failing retaining wall at the Historic Church, upgrading the heating system and repaving the driveway at the 27th Street facility, and repaving the parking lot at the Historic Church. We also launched the Restoration and Renovation Campaign for the Historic Church, and work has now started on the new rectory with another access to the 27th Street facility.

I can't think of another church parish that has accomplished so much within such a short time. It is all because of your generosity and God's blessings. Thank you for supporting these efforts!

It might be easy now to sit back in fear due to COVID-19. Instead, like St. Francis, we need to understand deeply our call to be evangelizers, to bring people to Christ. That is our Mission. We need to reach out and invite people to an encounter with Christ. We, ourselves, need to have an experience of Christ and facilitate it for others. Reaching out and evangelizing with a call to a deeper commitment to Christ is the thrust for the year 2022. To this end, we will need to hire another person to be on the Evangelization Team—to focus on youth and the young adult ministry—and have two other part-time support staff to assist the offices of Liturgy, Stewardship, and Communications.

My vision is to see a parish full of people who have chosen to be intentional disciples of Jesus and of his Church—parishioners who are enthusiastic about sharing the Good News, about inviting others to join us, and about building the Kingdom here in Bend. Please write the names of people you plan to invite, and put them in the basket in front of the altar, and pray for them daily. We intend to invite more

people to have an experience of Christ and place everyone at St. Francis on a path to true discipleship. Please join me in making this happen by supporting the following:

First, we must strengthen our **Offertory Collection**. We are a growing community with challenging needs. Bend is still one of the fastest growing cities in the country. Two churches, a school and many ministries make the Offertory Collection our highest priority. We need to recover from our offertory losses due to COVID-19. The expenses do not go down because some do not come to Church. We have been in touch with all of you using live-stream, Parish App, weekly emails and the parish website. If you have not been part of our email, phone call or regular email, you will need to register with the parish or call the office to update your information.

Second, we need to make our parish school affordable for all our parish families through the Parish Scholarship Fund. Thanks to your support, we were able to give financial aid to 42 students last year to attend St. Francis to a total of \$70,000. This year 44 students will receive financial aid from the Parish Scholarship Fund to a total of \$75,000. We need to continue to build up this fund.

The year 2022 will also be a year when we launch new programs such as Alpha to help us become a better community of intentional disciples driven by our mission to proclaim the Gospel. I ask you to support this year's stewardship drive, *Rebuild my Church*. Together, we will create a community of vibrant intentional disciples focused on bringing Christ to a hurting world.

Won't you join me? This is "first fruits"/commitment weekend. Please return your commitment card. Drop it off in the Offertory, or mail it in. We have extra pledge cards available on the baptismal font and in the narthex of both churches if you have forgotten or have not received one. Thanks for your commitment to become better stewards of God's blessings.

## The Prudent Steward— Tax-Wise Giving

As the year-end approaches and you consider your 2022 financial support of the parish, see if one of the options below makes sense for you:

- Over 70½? Make a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) from an IRA. There is no tax on the transfer, and it counts toward the RMD. Contact your plan administrator and Deacon Steve or Jane Rude for the required parish information. Many seniors find this a great way to give—especially if they cannot itemize their deductions.
- Give long-term appreciated stocks. This bypasses the tax on the capital gain, and you can deduct the fair market value of your gift if you itemize deductions. Contact your broker and Jane Rude or Deacon Steve for the required parish information.
