



From the Pastor



Go and Repair My House—Part 2

St. Francis of Assisi, whose feast day we celebrated last Monday, heard the Lord's call: "Restore my Church," while he knelt beneath the cross at San Damiano Church in Italy, and he responded by repairing not only that church, but other local churches in need of repair.

It was only later that he understood the Lord's request in its deeper meaning—rebuilding the entire Church spiritually. Last weekend, we kicked off the campaign for the renovation and restoration of the Historic Church. This campaign is about the way St. Francis understood his call at first. At our annual stewardship campaign next month, we will reflect on the second and the larger meaning of his call.

After the debt on the 27th Street Church was paid off, I included the renovation of the Historic Church as part of my "Vision 2025." After reviewing architectural plans and the results of the parish survey, the Historic Church Restoration Committee and the Parish and Finance Councils have approved moving forward with a \$1.5 million campaign to restore the sanctuary and the stained-glass windows in the Historic Church. You have probably seen the architect's renderings posted at both churches. I would like to have 70 percent of the total cost (\$1,050,000) in hand before we begin the work.

The good news is that the Restoration Fund has \$300,000, and the parish is committing an additional \$200,000 from the Capital Repairs Fund for this project. This means that we already have \$500,000 in hand and need only an additional \$550,000 to start the work.

If you have not already, you will be receiving information in the mail about this project, along

with a pledge card. If you do not receive the packet this week, we do have extra copies in the narthex of both churches. Please read the information carefully, pray, and then respond as generously as you can. If you or someone you know can make a larger gift, there are sponsorship opportunities available for items such as the altar, the ambo, statues, and stained-glass windows. Let me or Deacon Steve McGlone know if you would like to sponsor an item—with naming opportunities. This will be on a first-come, first-served basis.

In addition to seeking your support, the Restoration Committee is actively seeking funds from other sources, such as foundations. We need more help and expertise in this area. If you have experience in fund raising, or researching and applying for grants, please let me know.

Finally, I'd like to close with a paragraph from a recent article in the *National Catholic Register* by Timothy O'Donnell, president of Chistendom College:

"One of the greatest glories of the Middle Ages was the advent of Gothic architecture. With high pointed arches and stained-glass windows that flooded cathedrals with ethereal light, this architectural style lifted the heart and mind upwards towards contemplation of God. Now, in an era that can truly be described as another Dark Ages, where truth is stifled and Christ is marginalized, a return to beautiful architecture that raises one's eyes and soul to God is not just important, but also necessary."
