Stewardship 2024:

Being Disciples and Making Disciples —Part 2

All of us at St. Francis can take great pride in what we have accomplished over the last five years: paid off the \$3.1M debt, built a convent, welcomed Salesian Sisters to teach in the St. Francis School, strengthened the school financially, setup a Scholarship Fund, opened access to the 27th St. Church in two places, completed several deferred maintenance projects at both locations, built a New Rectory, began the Historic Church Restoration and Renovation Project, and initiated Alpha to evangelize and bring all to a deeper relationship with Christ. I can't think of another parish that has accomplished so much within such a short time. It is all because of your generosity and God's blessings. Thank you for supporting these efforts.

It might now be easy to sit back and relax. However, we have a way yet to go. We have to raise another \$300,000 to complete this phase of the Historic Church Renovation.

We had a campaign specifically for this purpose during the early part of this year. Twenty-six percent of the parishioners are making financial sacrifices to support the Historic Church Renovation. If you have not supported this effort, please consider doing so as your means allow.

The Annual Stewardship Campaign 2024, however, is to raise funds for the day-to-day operating expenses of St. Francis Parish and toward the Scholarship Fund to assist children attending our Catholic School.

Our call is to be evangelizers—to bring people to Christ. That is our Mission. We need to reach out and invite people to an encounter with Christ. We, ourselves, need to have an experience of Christ and facilitate it for others. Reaching out and evangelizing with a call to a deeper commitment to Christ is the thrust for Year 2024. We have successfully filled the positions on the Evangelization Team that are focused on youth and young adults, on Religious Education, and on facilities upkeep.

My vision is to see a parish full of people who have chosen to be intentional disciples of Jesus who are committed to worship, to grow, and to serve—

parishioners who are enthusiastic about sharing the Good News, about inviting others to join us, and about building the Kingdom here in Bend.

The theme for our Annual Stewardship Campaign 2024, *Being Disciples and Making Disciples*, embraces who we are as a community and what we hope to accomplish. Together we deepen our commitment to be Christ's disciples and make disciples for Him. To help us in these efforts, I hope to have one or two FOCUS missionaries joining us by Fall of the coming year. To be able to accomplish all these, I ask your support in the following areas:

- **Offertory**—your regular offertory gift provides the resources we need for daily operation of our parish. It is the lifeblood of our parish and enables us to truly live our missionary calling. As everything else, the operational cost has risen about 7 percent over last year. We are a growing community with challenging needs.
- **Scholarship Fund**—your support of our Scholarship Fund invests in our future by ensuring a quality Catholic Education for the leaders of tomorrow. It is my hope that no child in Bend be denied a quality Catholic Education for financial reasons. Your support has enabled 26 students to attend our school this year.

Please prayerfully consider how you can best respond to this Appeal, and return the commitment card by "Commitment Weekend," October 21–22. You may return the card by mail, drop it by the parish office, or drop it in the collection basket at Mass. Supporting our church financially is not an option but an obligation. I would be surprised to learn if there is someone in our parish who cannot sacrifice \$10 (or even \$5) a month to support your Church. Please return the card even if you cannot make a financial commitment at this time. That will let us know that we have your prayerful support for the success of the campaign. God bless your sacrifices.

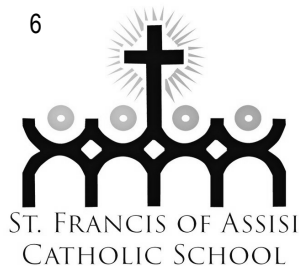
