Remembering Those Gone Before Us

In the month of November, the Church meditates on the Communion of Saints (Church Triumphant), the Faithful Departed who are still expiating their sins in Purgatory (Church Suffering), and the Pilgrim Faithful here on earth (Church Militant). "In this wonderful exchange, the holiness of one profits others, well beyond the harm that the sin of one could cause others" (*Catechism of the Catholic Church*, 1475).

On Wednesday, November 1st, we celebrate the Solemnity of All Saints, a holy day of obligation. On Thursday, November 2nd, we celebrate All Souls Day. The month of November is dedicated to remembering our Faithful Departed. The need and duty of prayer for the departed souls has been acknowledged by the Church at all times. It is recommended in the Scriptures of the Old Testament: "It is therefore a holy and wholesome thought to pray for the dead, that they may be loosed from sins" (2 Maccabees 12, 46). This duty has found expression not only in public and private prayers but especially in the offering of the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass for the repose of souls. We can also relieve their sufferings through our prayers, sufferings and penances.

If you wish to offer Masses for your departed loved ones during the month of November, use the Mass Intentions forms to submit your intentions. These are available in the narthex of the church and in the parish office. Masses for those intentions will be celebrated by priests of the Salesian Religious Order that I was part of. The stipend that you offer will go to the Salesian Mission in India. Thanks for supporting them.

We can also help the Poor Souls by doing acts and prayers that have indulgences at-



tached to them. An indulgence is "the remission

before God of the temporal punishment due for sins already forgiven as far as their guilt is concerned." It is partial if it removes only part of the temporal punishment due to sin, or plenary if it removes all punishment. A partial indulgence can be obtained by devoutly visiting a cemetery and praying for the departed, even if the prayer is only mental. **One can gain a plenary indulgence by visiting a cemetery each day between November 1st and November 8th.** These indulgences are applicable only to the Souls in Purgatory. The faithful need to make a confession and receive communion to fulfill all conditions needed to obtain indulgences.

A partial indulgence, applicable only to the Souls in Purgatory, can be obtained when the *Eternal Rest (Requiem aeternam)* is prayed. This can be prayed all year, but especially during the month of November: *Eternal rest* grant to them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May the souls of the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen.

On November 2nd, the feast of All Souls, you are welcome to bring pictures of your deceased loved ones to Mass and place them below the altar to be prayed for. Apart from the regular Holy Masses at 7 a.m. and 12:15 p.m., there will be a prayer and blessing at Greenwood / Pilot Butte cemetery at 1:30 p.m. In the month of November we are called in a special way to remember "our brothers and sisters who have fallen asleep in the hope of the resurrection." May the souls of all the faithful departed through the mercy of God rest in peace.
