




# From the Pastor



## Stewardship 2023— *Belong, Believe, Be Disciples: Part I*

**G**od made known his vision for St. Francis of Assisi as he knelt underneath a large wooden crucifix in San Damiano: “Francis, Francis, go and repair my house which, as you can see, is falling into ruins.” Taking that command very literally, Francis set about physically rebuilding the little church—stone by stone. He did the same with other abandoned churches in the area, having gone about begging for help to complete his work. Only later did he understand the call in a broader sense.

Francis’ call was not just to rebuild the Church physically but also spiritually. He, therefore, went about preaching, evangelizing, and calling people to a deeper commitment to Christ. And, that is our focus for the Annual Stewardship Campaign 2023—*Belong, Believe, Be Disciples*.

As we prepare to renew our financial commitment to St. Francis Parish, I would like to reflect with you on our call to be good stewards. The goal of our life is holiness, and stewardship is the practical way to get there. Thus, when we live as good stewards, we are living holy lives. Holiness means being close to the Lord, being close to His Church, being close to its mission, open to God’s word, and open to the Sacraments. Stewardship is not a fund-raising technique. Then what is it? It is:

- ◆ **Scripture Based:** All of the teachings of stewardship come directly from the Old Testament, the Gospels, and the letters of the New Testament. It is the way God has expected His people to live since the beginning of time.
- ◆ **A Love Response:** Once we allow God to truly take up residence in our hearts, we become so overwhelmed by His abundant love for us that we just naturally feel the need to respond to Him by sharing the gifts to carry out God’s work here on earth.
- ◆ **Dependence on God:** Stewardship is recognizing that everything we have is a gift from God. Everything we have and everything we do is a result of some gift that God has placed into our hands.

- ◆ **Giving Back:** Stewardship is returning a portion of our gifts to God. The gifts we return are our time, our talent, and our treasures. We return these gifts not because God or our Church needs them, but because we feel an overwhelming need to show our love and gratitude to God.
- ◆ **Proportionate Giving:** Stewardship calls us to realize that each of us is called to give as God has given to us. We no longer base our giving on what others are giving. Rather, we give in proportion to all that God has given to us.
- ◆ **Trusting in God:** Stewardship is trusting God. We believe that our generous God will always provide for us. The test of trust is sacrifice.
- ◆ **Accountability:** Stewardship calls us to recognize that just as in the Parable of the Talents, each of us will someday be asked by God to give an accounting of all that we have done with the gifts that have been given to us.
- ◆ **Transformative:** Stewardship is transformative. It is making God at the center of our life and all our decision making. God will be first at our every decision making. Stewardship becomes a total way of life and the path to holiness.

In short, stewardship is the path to becoming intentional disciples of Christ. In 1992, the U.S. Catholic Bishops released a pastoral letter on stewardship entitled: *Stewardship: A Disciple’s Response*. I would encourage you to read this to get to know more about stewardship. The pastoral letter on stewardship gives a wonderful and detailed explanation of stewardship. It can be found on the USCCB website: <http://www.usccb.org/stewardship/disciplesresponse.pdf>.

May St. Francis of Assisi, the patron saint of our parish—whose feast day we will celebrate **on Tuesday, October 4th**—inspire us to support the Mission of our Church as good stewards.


## Come and See . . .


## Pregnancy & Infant Loss Remembrance
