

# From the Pastor

## Stewardship 2023— *Belong, Believe, Be Disciples: Part IV*



God has called us to build His kingdom here on earth. All of us have a role in building up God's kingdom. He has given us the gifts of time, talent, and treasure to help us in that work. As baptized persons, we make up the Church. The Church is not a building, but it comes from a Greek word, *Ecclesia*, which means "those called out" or "people of God." Thus, if we make up the Church, then when we say that the Church has the responsibility to spread the Gospel, to worship God, to educate children, to care for the poor and needy, we are saying that **WE** have the responsibility to do these.

Our Catholic ancestors were great stewards. The evidence of their generosity is seen all over our country, including here in Bend. The Historic Church, built over 100 years ago, is a great testimony to their generous stewardship. Stewardship is a way of living each day in gratitude for all the blessings that God has given us. We are here on earth to use God's gifts **to do God's work**. Giving time and talent does not excuse us from giving treasure. We can demonstrate that we put God first by making a conscious effort to make a financial gift to God first, before we pay our bills and buy the things we want.

Why does the Church need your gifts? Your contributions help to pay the staff, to provide faith education, to pay the utility bills that keep the lights on and keep the rooms cool in summer and warm in winter. As a Church and a School, we provide Catholic education and evangelize children and their families. We purchase many supplies needed for the office, liturgies, and sacraments, including hosts, wine, candles, oil, prayer books, hymnals, and so on. None of these items are free. The maintenance and upkeep are very expensive for our facilities. Contact the parish office if you would like to get a copy of the Church expenses to see how your contributions

are spent. The Church entirely depends on your weekly contributions. Your absence at Church does not bring down the expense. Our expenses have only gone up due to COVID-19 and the resulting inflation and tight labor market.

There are many ways in which you can give your gift to God. Some of them include: a gift of securities, a charitable gift annuity, a charitable rollover gift, a gift of a life insurance policy, an estate gift through your will, a year-end gift, a single charity fund, an endowment gift to honor your loved one, etc. If you need more information about this, the parish office can help you.

A commitment in the area of finance is something that many of us are reluctant to make, especially during these uncertain circumstances. Yet, it is precisely now that we are called to **trust Him**. This is **growing in discipleship**. "Any one of you who does not renounce all that he has cannot be my disciple" (Lk. 14:33). The path to discipleship involves placing God first in our lives. The test of our faith and trust in God is sacrifice. The "first fruits" / "commitment" weekend was two weekends ago. God bless your sacrifices on behalf of His Church. "Whoever gives one of these little ones even a cup of cold water because he is a disciple, truly, I say to you, he will by no means lose his reward" (Mt. 10:42).




