

From the Pastor



Stewardship 2023— *Belong, Believe, Be Disciples: Part II*

All of us at St. Francis can take great pride in what we have accomplished over the last five years—paid off the \$3.1 million debt, built a convent, welcomed Salesian Sisters to teach in the school, strengthened the School financially, set up a Scholarship Fund, opened two accesses to the 27th Street Church, completed the much-needed deferred maintenance projects at both locations, reached 76% of the Historic Church Restoration and Renovation goal, built a new Rectory and initiated Alpha to evangelize and bring all to a deeper relationship with Christ. I can't think of another Church that has accomplished so much within such a short time. It is all because of your generosity and God's blessings. Thank you for supporting these efforts.

It might be now easy to sit back in fear of an economic uncertainty. Instead, like St. Francis, we need to look forward with hope, trust, and commitment. We need to understand deeply our call to be evangelizers, to bring people to Christ. That is our Mission. We need to reach out and invite people to an encounter with Christ. We, ourselves, need to have an experience of Christ and facilitate it for others. Reaching out and evangelizing with a call to a deeper commitment to Christ is the thrust for the year 2023. We've been looking for months to hire people to fill various positions, but we have not been successful. Please pray that the Lord will send us the right candidates to be on the Evangelization Team, focused on youth and young adults, for Religious Education, and for our facilities upkeep.

My vision is to see a parish full of people who have chosen to be intentional disciples of Jesus who are committed to worship, grow, and serve—parishioners who are enthusiastic about sharing the Good News, about inviting others to join us, and about building the Kingdom here in Bend.

The theme for our Annual Stewardship Campaign 2023, *Belong, Believe, Be Disciples*, embraces who we are as a community and who we want to be. Together we *belong* to the community of believers, the Parish of St. Francis of Assisi. Together we *believe* in

the teachings of Christ enunciated by the Catholic Church. Together we grow to *be disciples* of Christ.

This year we request your support for the following three areas of our Stewardship Campaign:

- ♦ **Offertory**—your regular offertory gift provides the resources we need for daily operation of our parish. It is the lifeblood of our parish and enables us to truly live our missionary calling. As everything else, the operational cost has increased about 10% over last year. We are a growing community with challenging needs.
- ♦ **Historic Church Restoration**—we have raised in a year 76% of the funds necessary for this project to ensure the iconic Historic Church remains a part of the vibrant Catholic faith in Bend for generations to come. We need the remaining fund at least in pledges before we can begin the project.
- ♦ **Scholarship Fund**—your support of our Scholarship Fund invests in our future by ensuring a quality Catholic Education for the leaders of tomorrow. It is my hope that no child in Bend will be denied a quality Catholic Education for financial reasons.

Please prayerfully consider how you can best respond to this appeal, and return the commitment card by Commitment Weekend, October 15/16. You may return the card by mail, drop it by the parish office, or drop it in the collection basket at Mass. Supporting our church financially is not an option but an obligation. I will be surprised to learn if there is someone in our parish who cannot sacrifice \$10 (or even \$5) a month to support the Church. It is important that you return the card even if you cannot make a financial commitment at this time. That will let us know that we have your prayerful support for the success of the campaign.

Christmas Tamales!




