

From the Pastor



Alpha: Bringing the Mission to the Center of Our Church's Life and Activities—Part 1

What is our Mission? One of the important priorities for our parish that I set forth in my “Vision 2025” is evangelization. As a Church community, we exist to evangelize. Our primary mission is to make disciples for Christ. That was the final wish and command that Jesus left with His disciples before He ascended into heaven: “Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you” (Mt. 28:19).

“We cannot forget that evangelization is first and foremost about preaching the Gospel to those who do not know Jesus Christ. . . . Many of them are quietly seeking God, led by a yearning to see His face, even in countries of ancient Christian tradition. All of them have a right to receive the Gospel. Christians have the duty to proclaim the Gospel without excluding anyone.”

—*Pope Francis, Evangelii Gaudium, 15*

Why to Evangelize? “For the disciple of Christ to evangelize is an obligation of love” (St. John Paul II).

We need to become more and more an evangelizing community here in Bend. There are so many in town who do not know of Christ. We have a mission to reach out to them while deepening our own faith.

Evangelization needs to take priority and everything we do should be centered on deepening our own faith and bringing others to Christ.

Ever since the pandemic started, a small group of us, led by Dcn. Steve, met to pray and to discern a path to become a strong evangelizing community. We have been evaluating various evangelization tools that are available to us.

This small group has met numerous times. The tool that we would like to use in our parish to advance in our Mission to evangelize is **Alpha**. This small group has spent numerous hours going over this wonderful tool of evangelization.

What is Alpha? Alpha is the basic message of Jesus Christ. It is a series of sessions exploring the Christian faith, typically run over 11 weeks. Each talk looks at a different question around faith and is designed to create conversation.

Alpha is run all around the globe, and everyone is welcome. Alpha activities are all around the world in cafés, churches, universities, homes, bars—you name it. No two Alphas look the same, but they have three key things in common: food, a talk, and good conversation.

Who is Alpha's Audience? Alpha is for everyone but primarily for the unchurched, for those who are not Christian, and those who have little or no familiarity with Jesus. But, we need you to reach out to them and to accompany them to Alpha. It's a place where anyone is welcome to come with their questions and concerns—regardless of their commitment level to the Church or to God. Because of this, some of us may think that the concepts are more introductory than you need. If you are one of them, consider this a refresher for your heart as well as your head.

Is it for me? The truth is that many Catholics have been sacramentalized without ever having been evangelized. Many Catholics today are interested in checking off the list of sacraments they have received and that their children have received without being truly evangelized or having had a personal encounter with Christ. Alpha is the perfect opportunity for that encounter with Christ.

The content of Alpha never changes, but the context in which it runs is constantly changing. Alpha is run throughout the world by Christians of all traditions, providing a common expression of “proclamation, service, and witness” (EG, 246).

I invite you to participate in Alpha. How can you invite someone to it if you do not know what this is?

Sacramental Preparation



If your child attended Faith Formation last year, **First Communion** can be received as early as 2nd grade, and **Confirmation** can be received as early as 6th grade. If you believe that your child is ready to prepare for a sacrament, and you as parents are ready to accept responsibility for helping your child fulfill all requirements, then use the Faith Formation registration form to sign up.

For families with children receiving sacraments this year, there are four required family monthly workshops and a requirement to attend three Family Faith events.

Wednesday, September 14th, is the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross.


